

Alumni/ae participation is a vital sign of institutional strength. Strong alumni/ae involvement shows your personal and class commitment to our shared mission.


Your classmates, as well as the students, staff and faculty, are looking forward to celebrating your class reunion on April 22-23, 2009. We hope you will be there.
