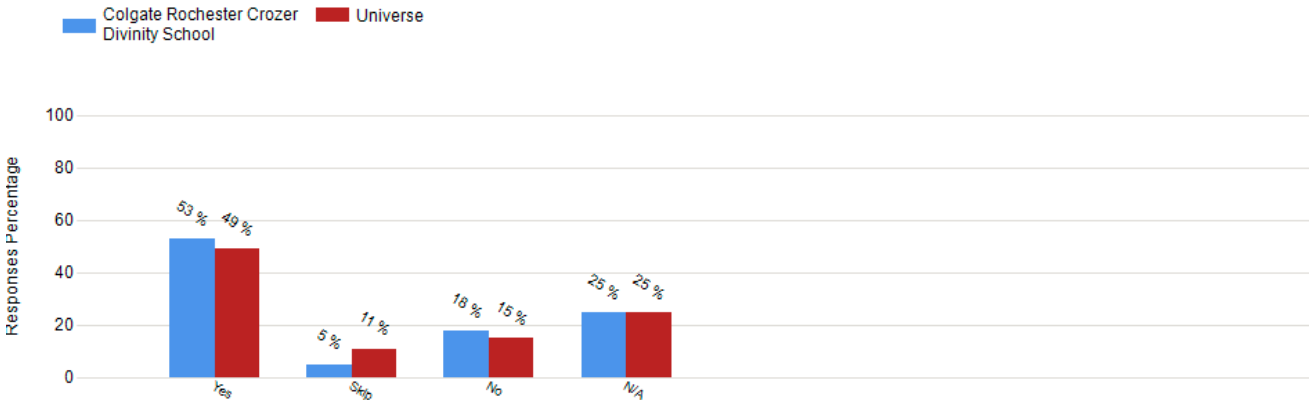

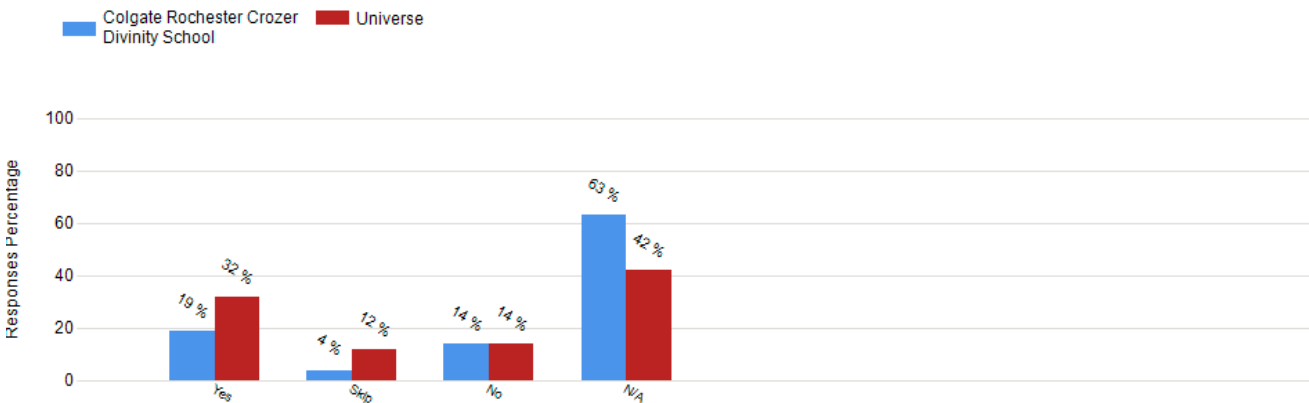
Have you ever spoken up if you heard someone making jokes about another person's body?

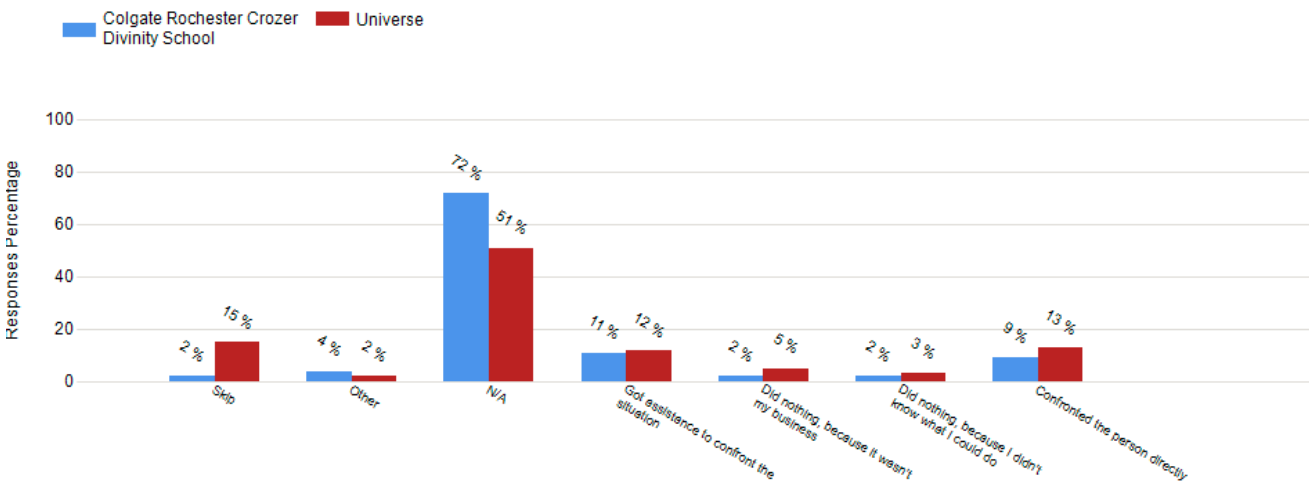
Have you ever spoken up if you saw a group of students sexually bothering or intimidating another student?

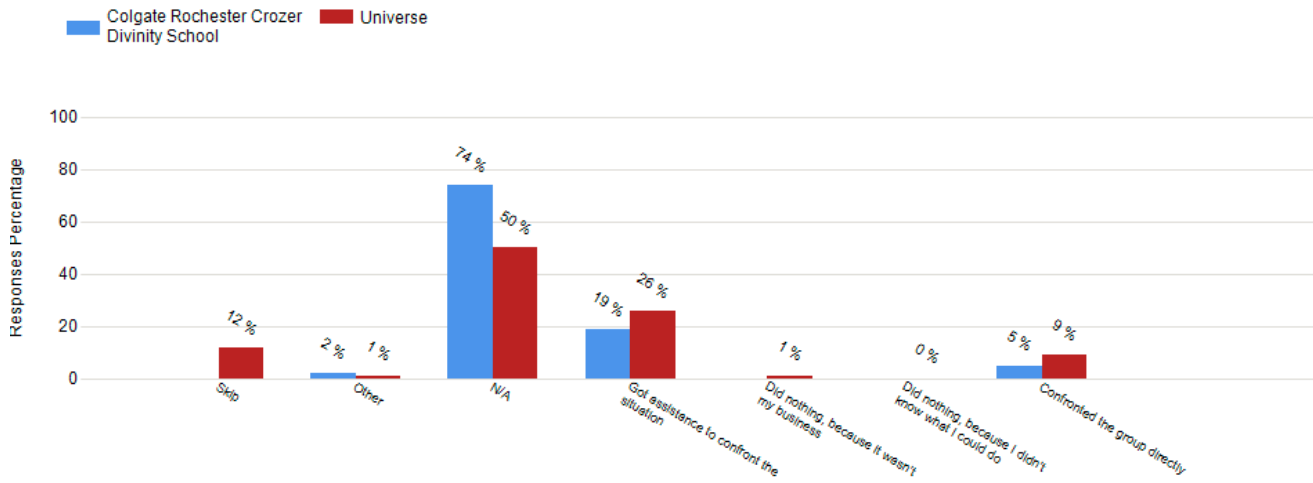
If you ever saw someone taking a drunk student to their room, what did you do?

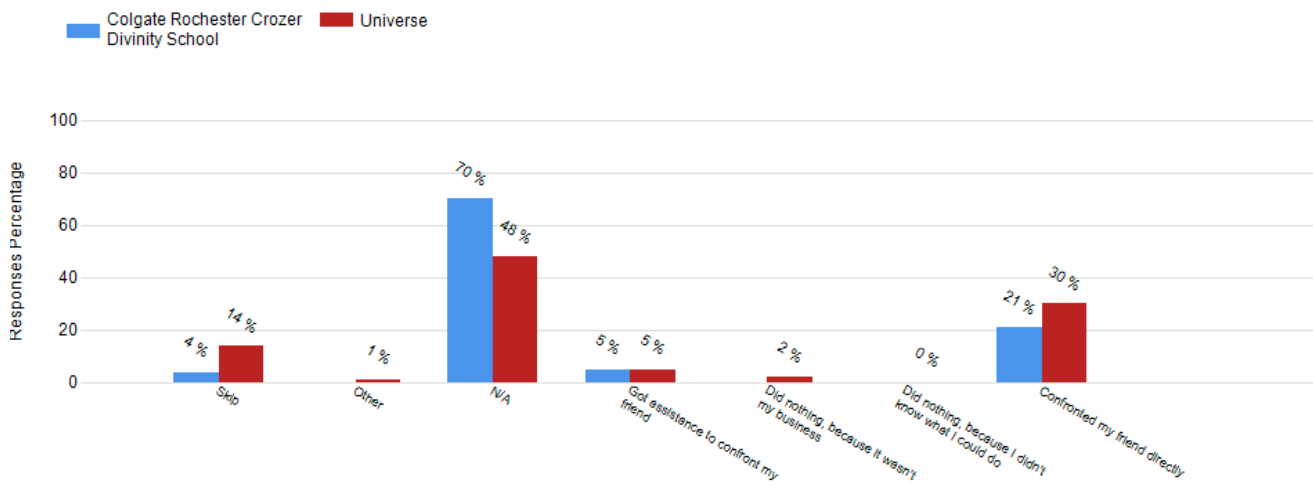
If you ever saw a group of people go into a room and then heard someone yelling for help, what did you do?

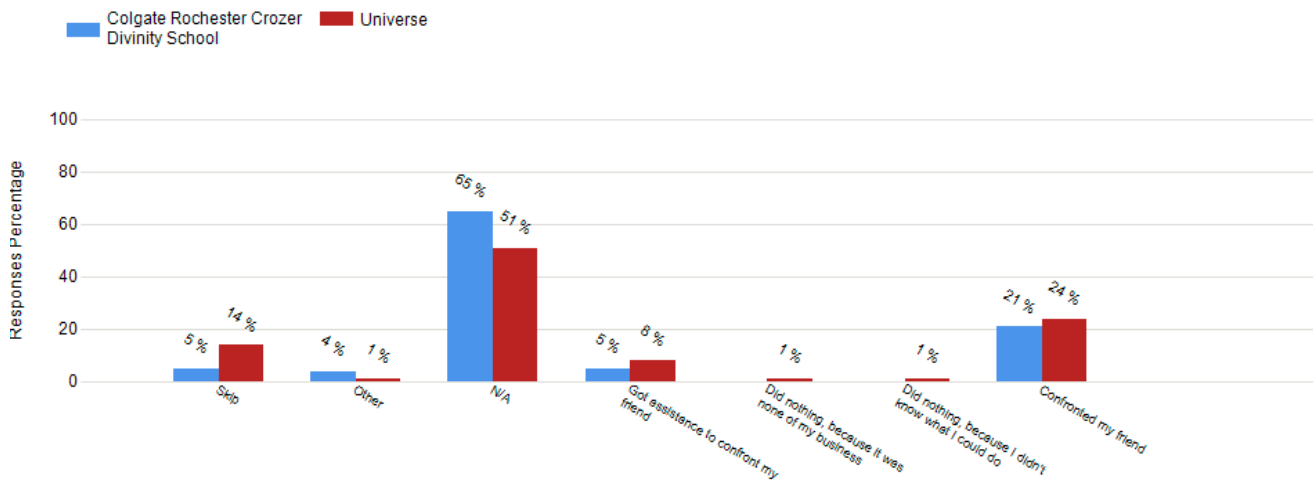
If you ever heard a friend say they planned to use alcohol in order to get sex, what did you do?

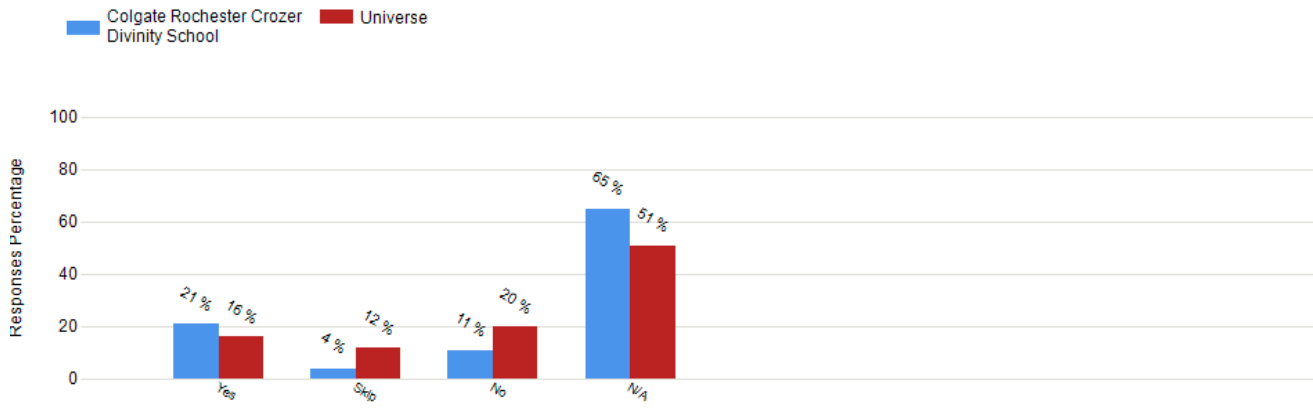
If you ever heard a rumor that a friend forced someone to have sex, what did you do?

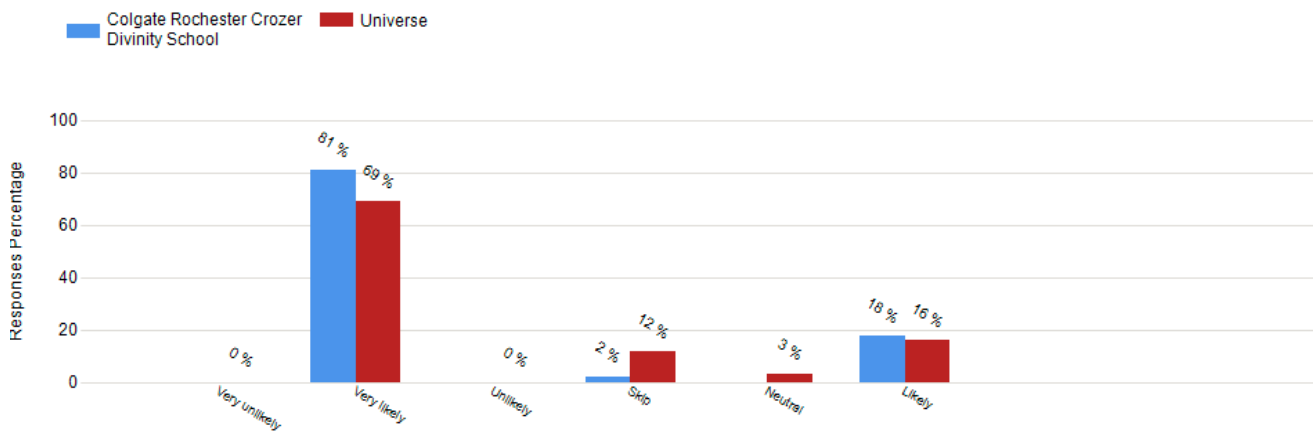

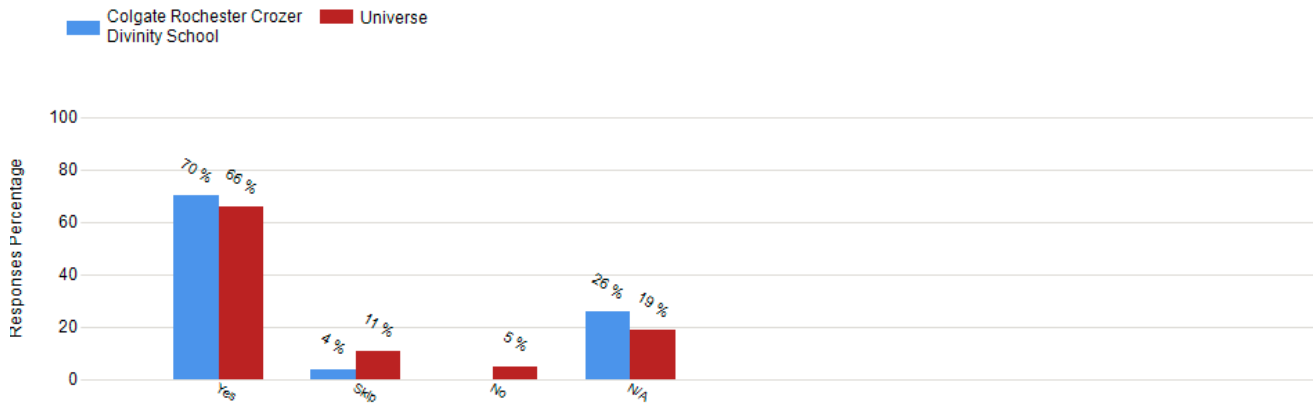
How likely are you to call for help in the future if you saw someone who needed help?

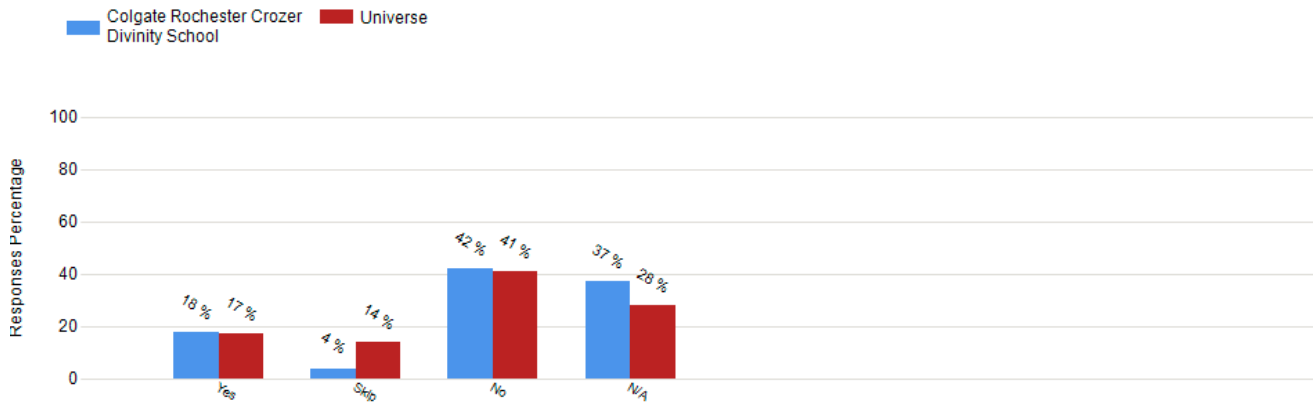
Have you ever stood up for someone who was being bullied?

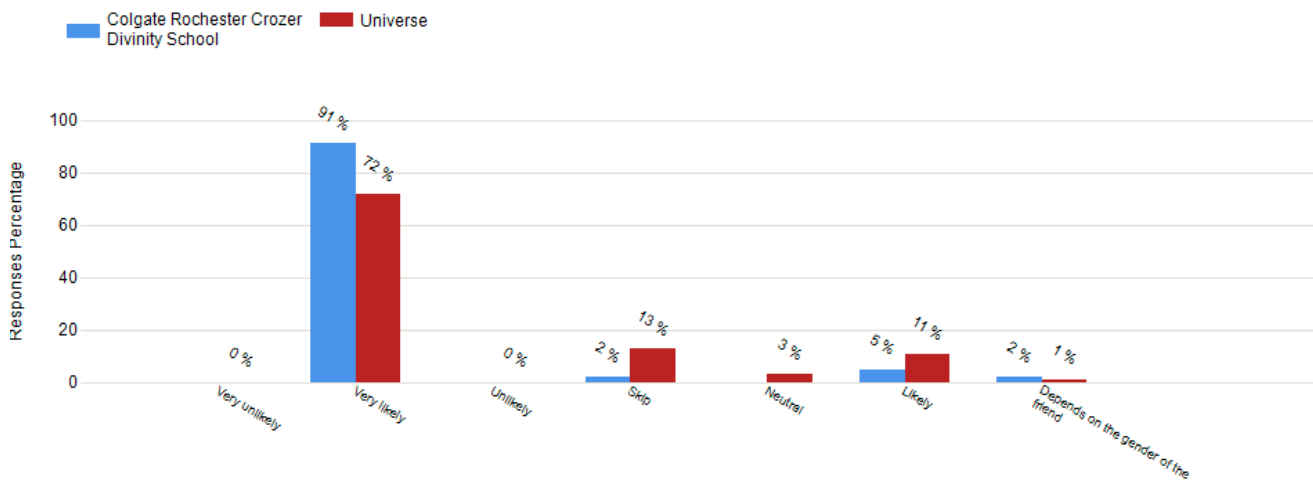
Have you ever resisted getting involved in a situation where you knew someone needed help, because you feared negative action against yourself (including fearing for your own safety)?

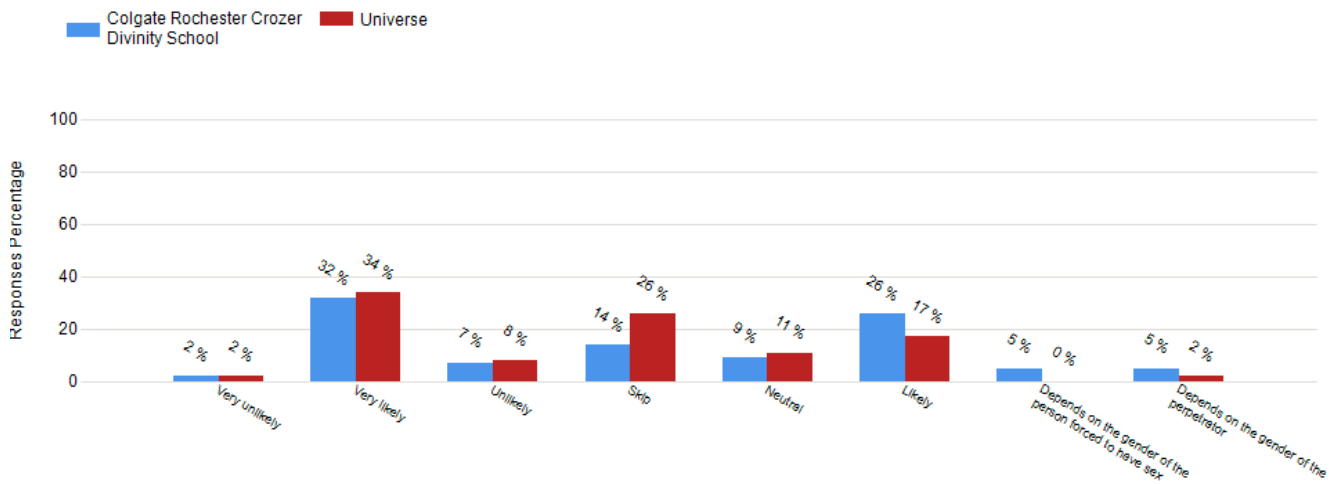
How likely are you to go with a friend to the police station if he or she said (s)he was raped?

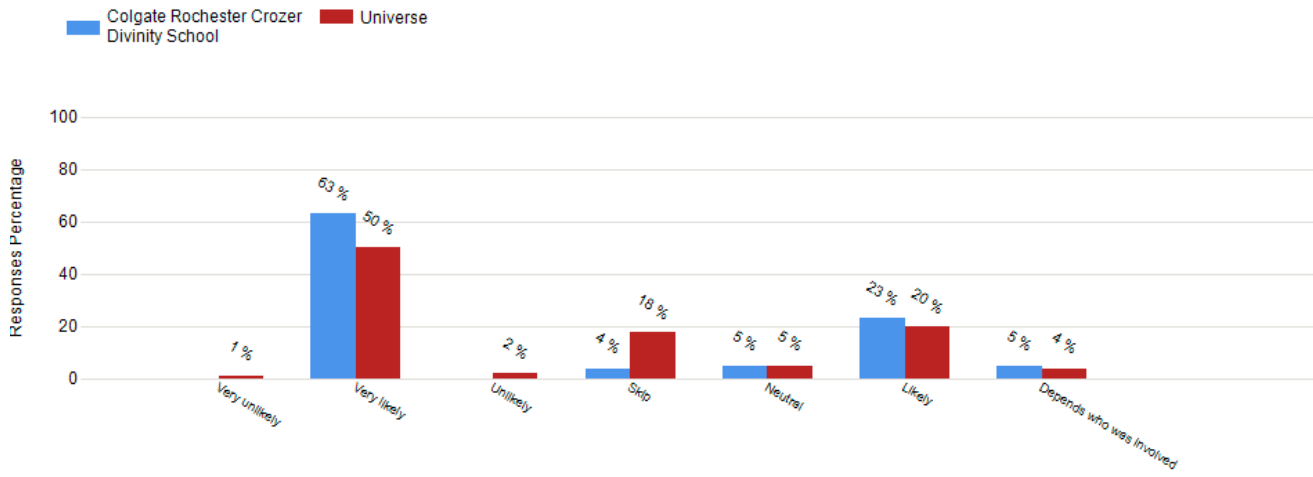
How likely are you to confront someone if you heard rumors they forced someone to have sex?

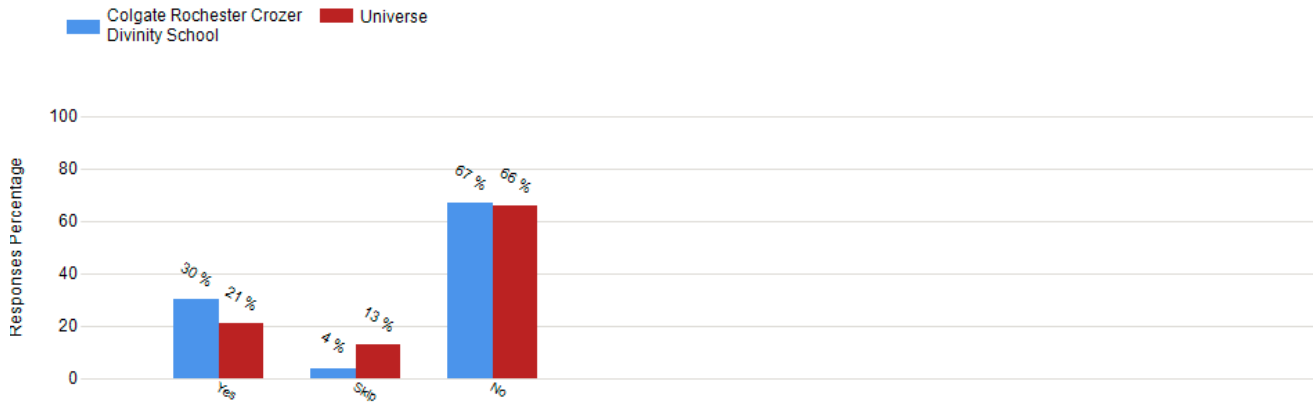

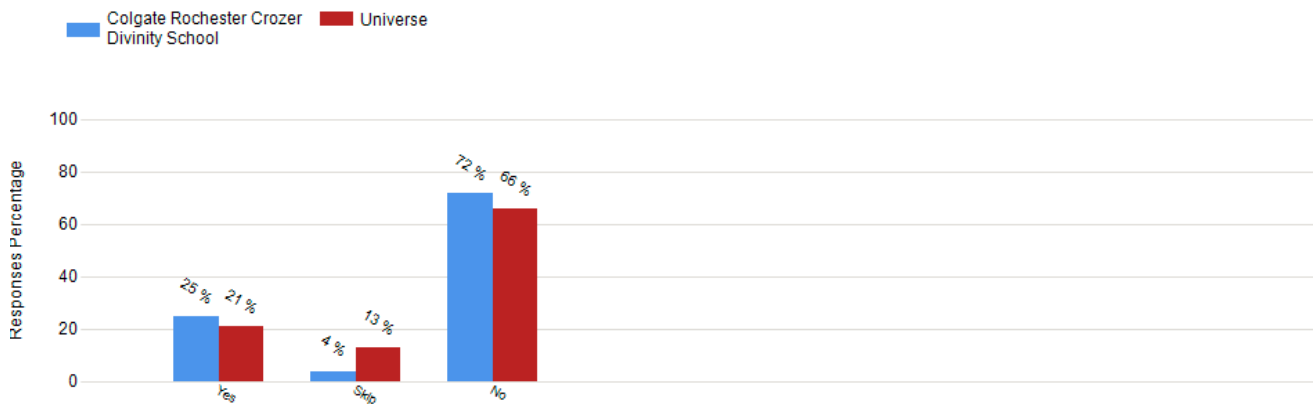
Have you, or someone you know, been hit, slapped or restrained against your will by a partner in a romantic relationship?

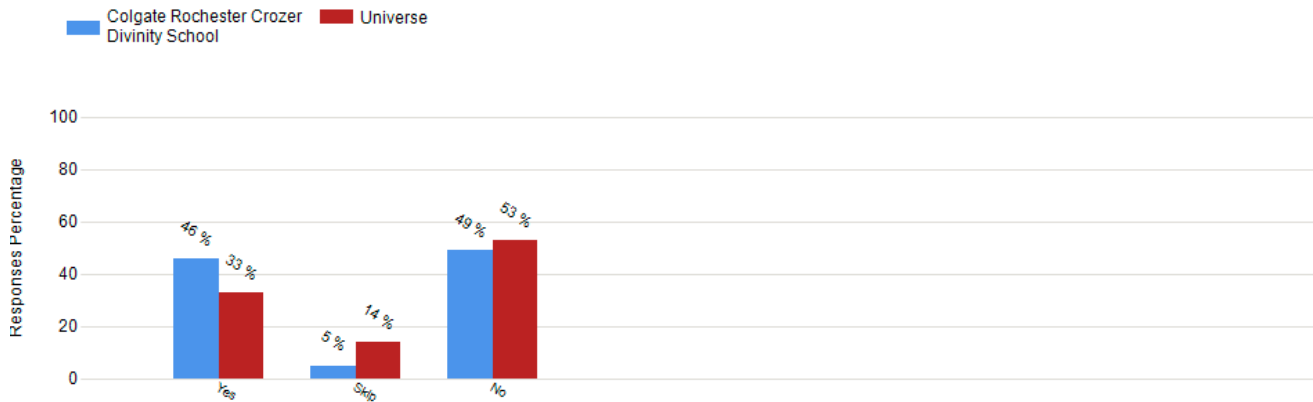
Have you, or someone you know, been pressured by a romantic partner to regularly cancel or not make plans with family or friends?

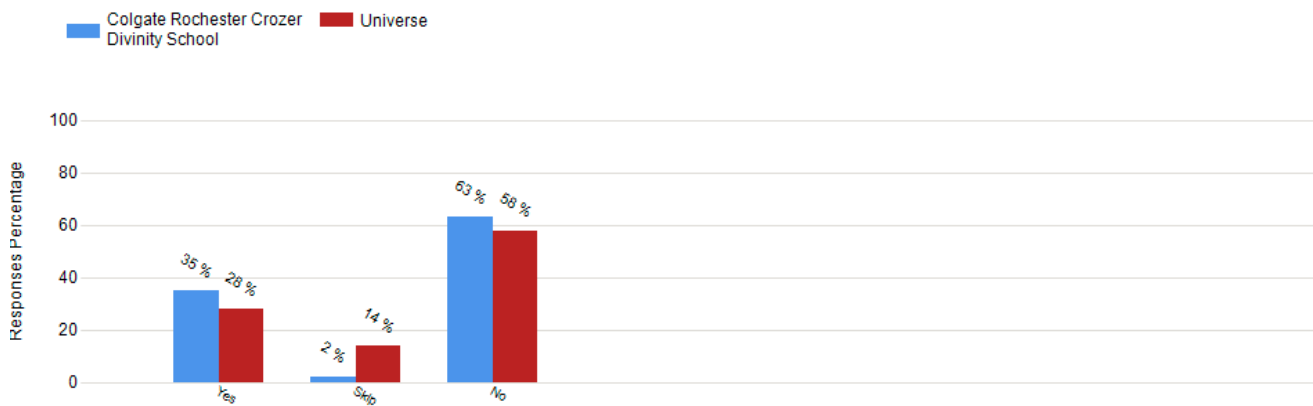
Have you, or someone you know, been emotionally or psychologically abused by a partner in a romantic relationship?

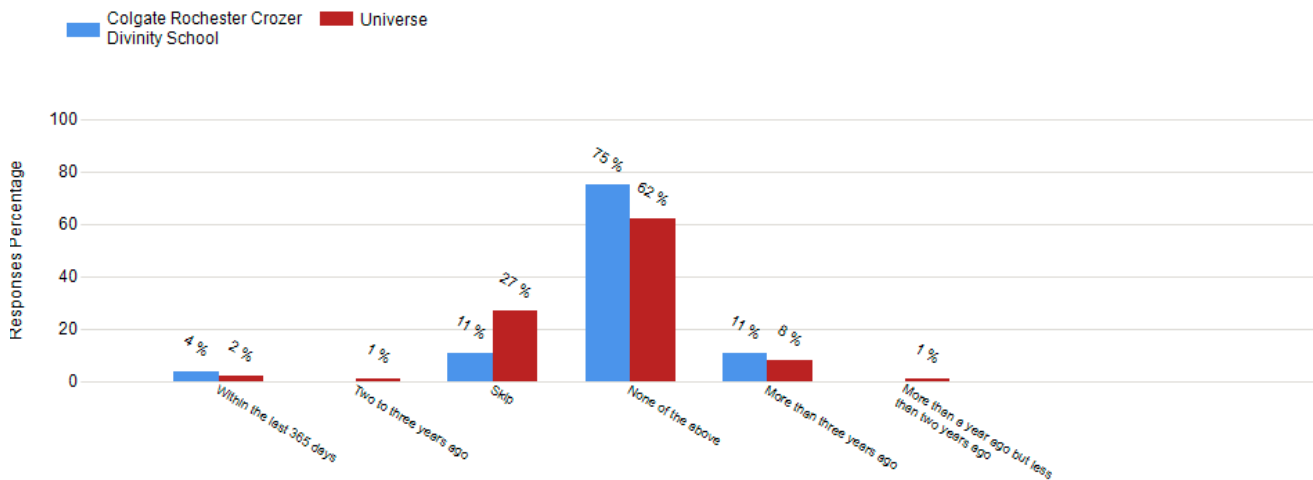

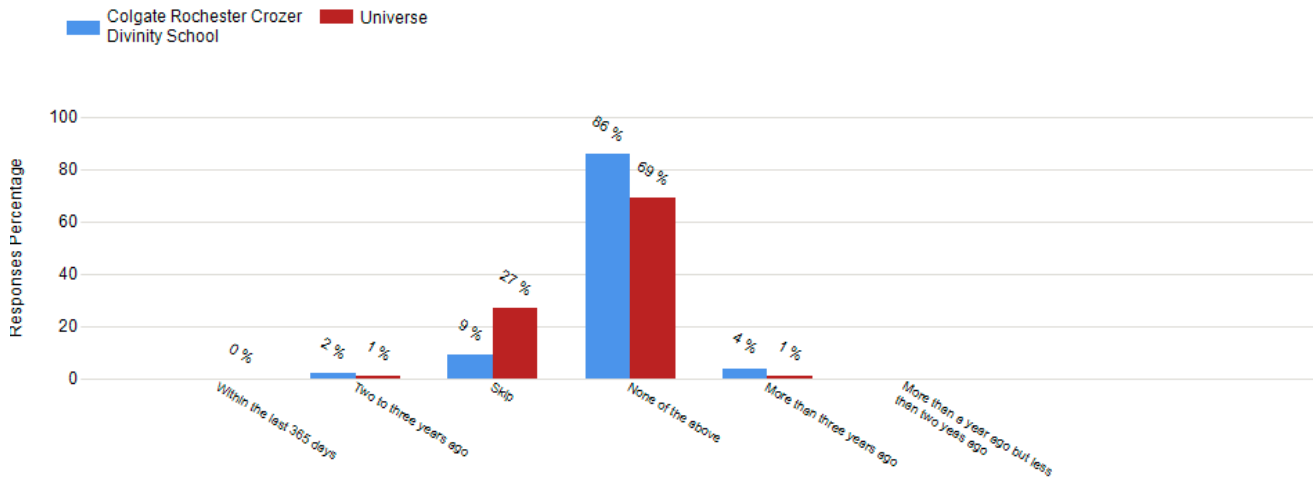

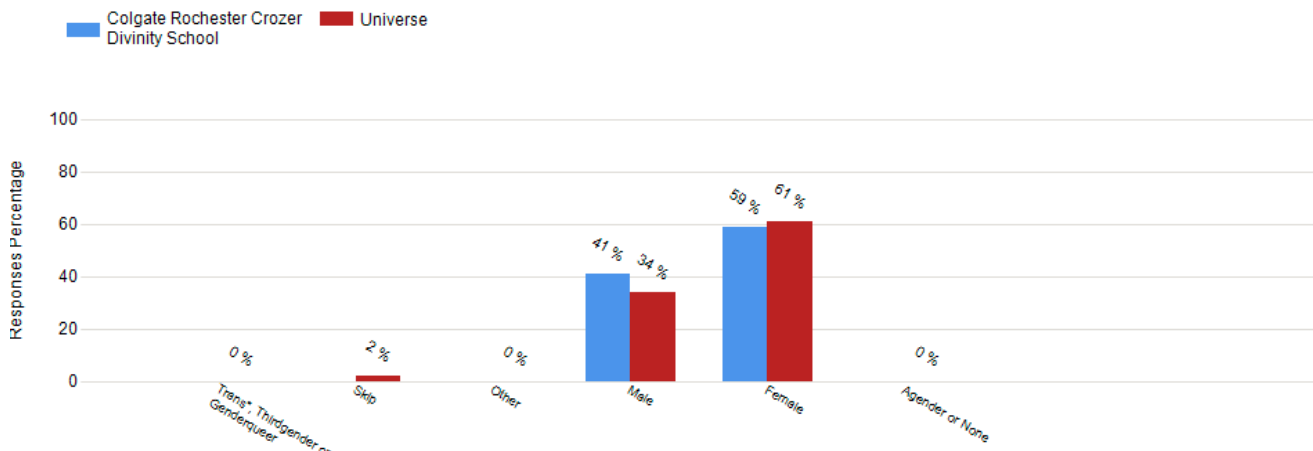

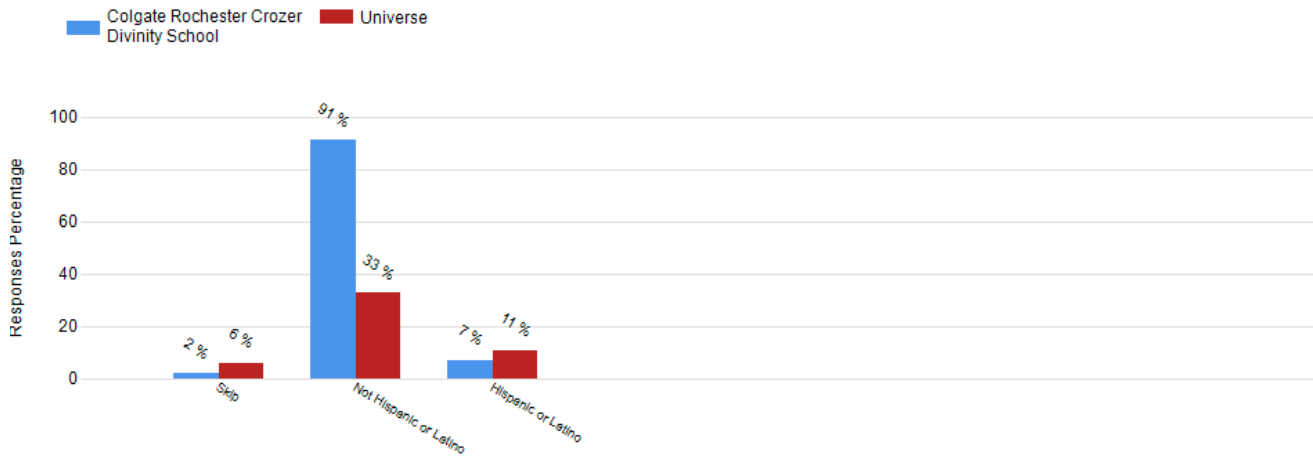
What is your current gender identity?

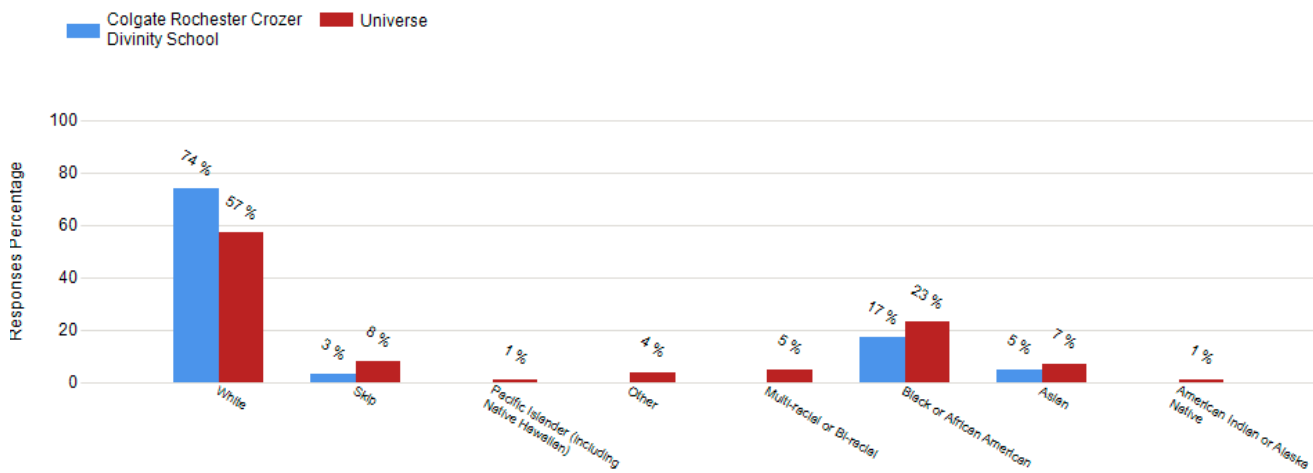

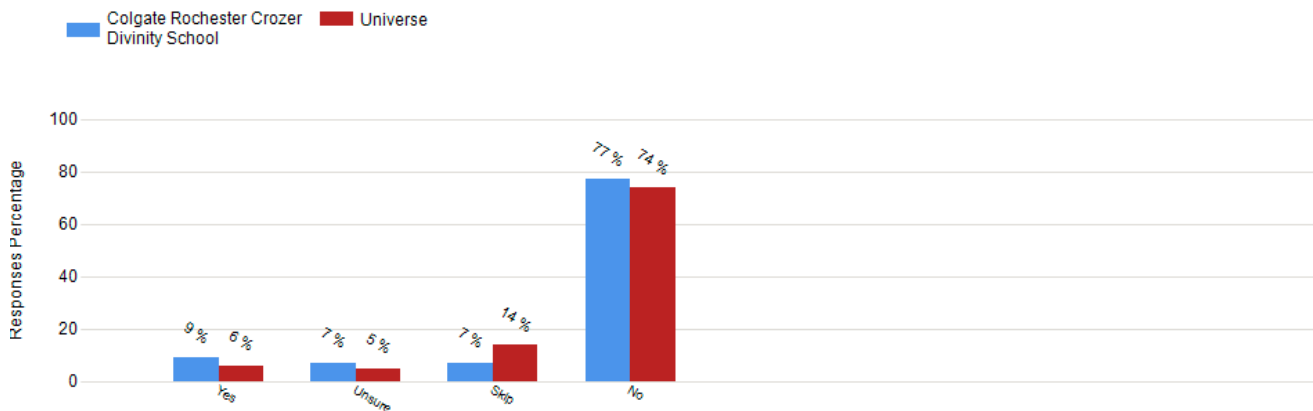

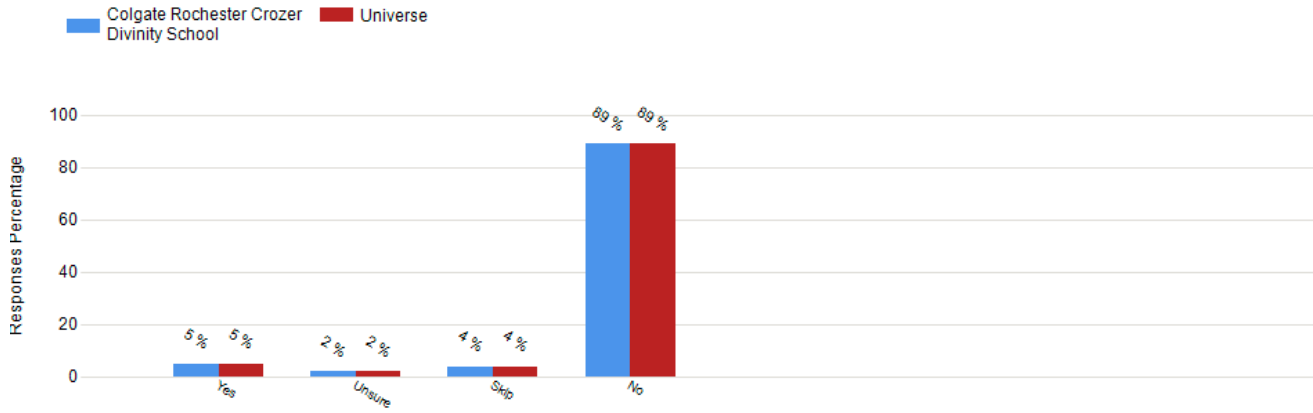
Have you ever faced discrimination at this school by someone in a position of authority?

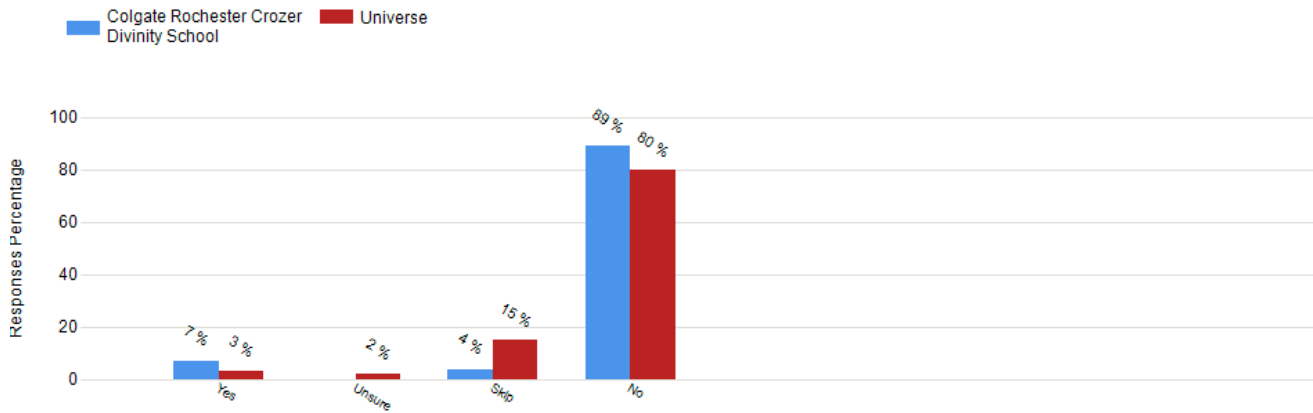
Have you ever faced harassment at this school by students?

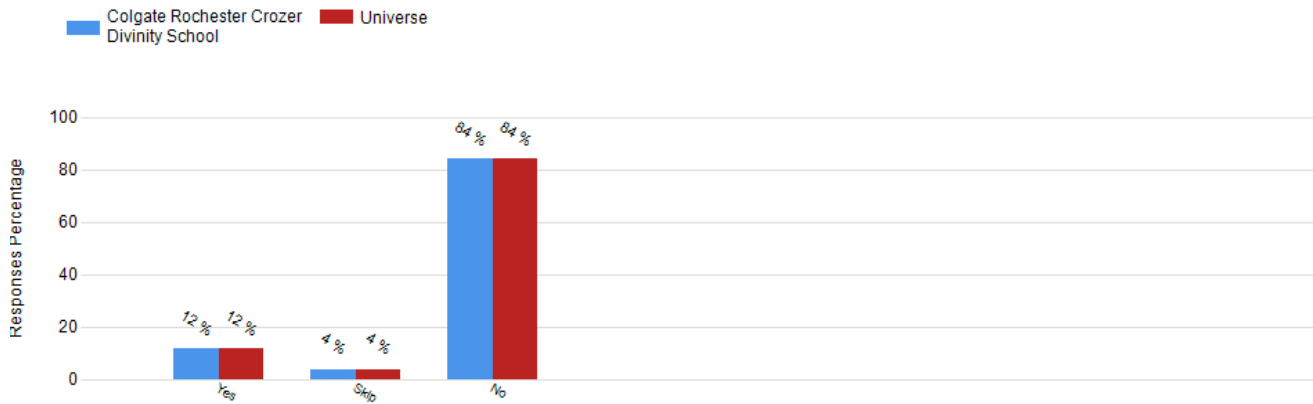
Have you ever faced harassment at this school by members of the community other than students (employees, parents, etc.)?

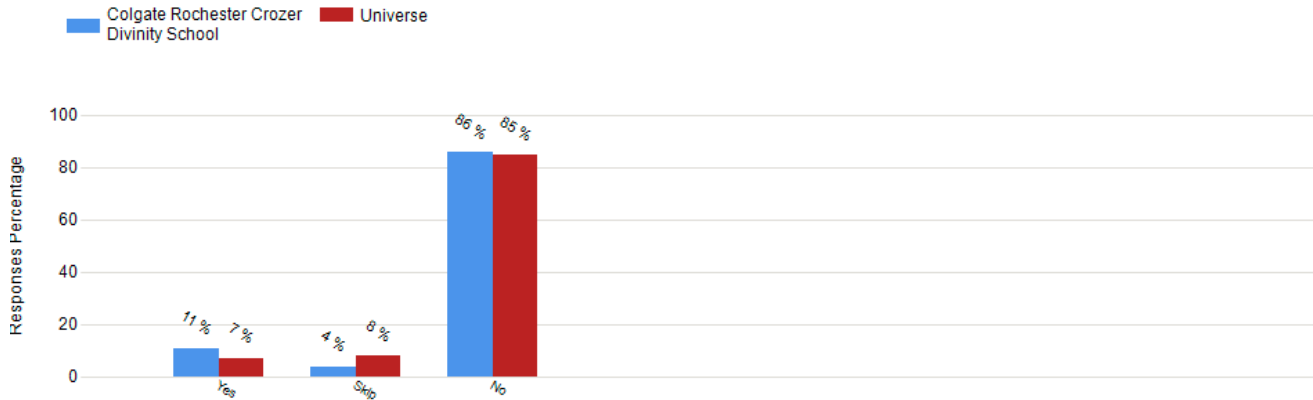

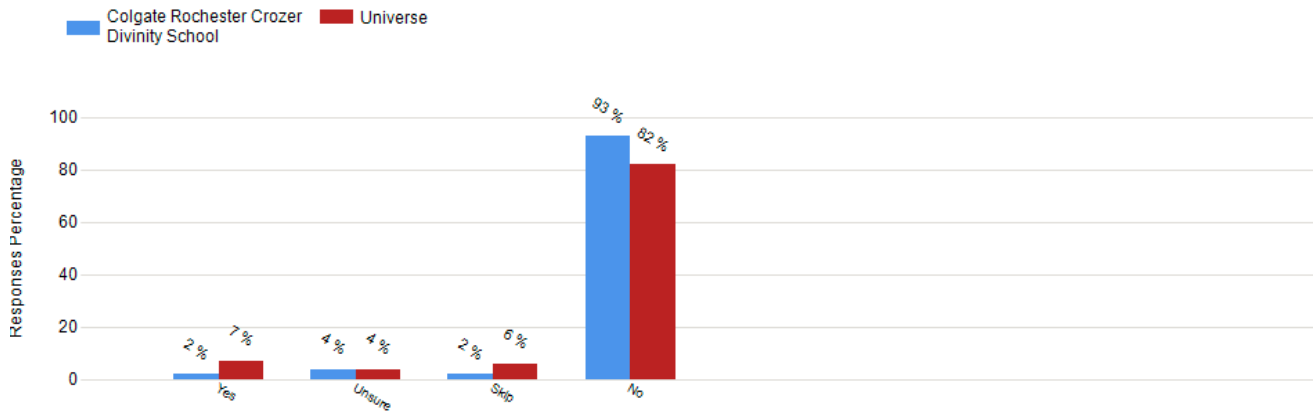
Have you, or someone you know, ever given another person alcohol in an attempt to get sex?

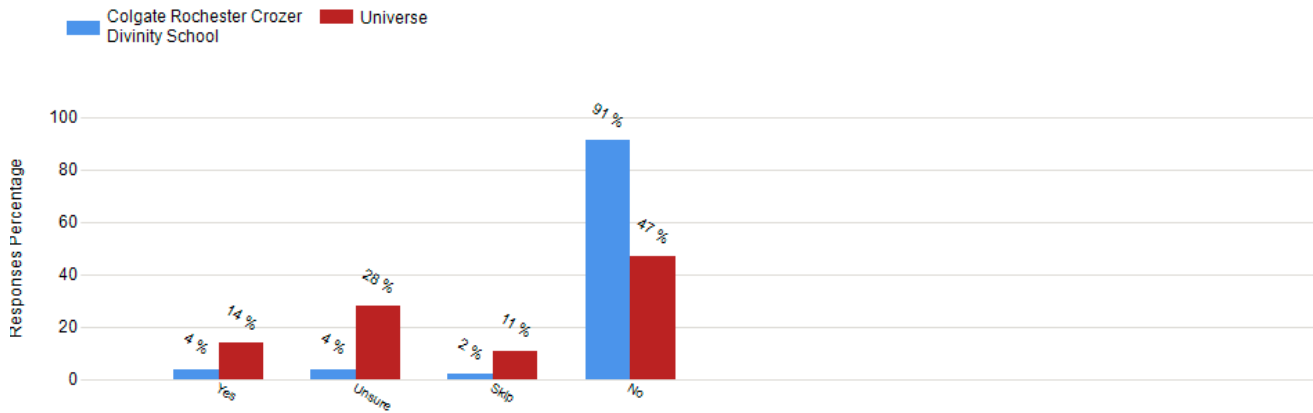

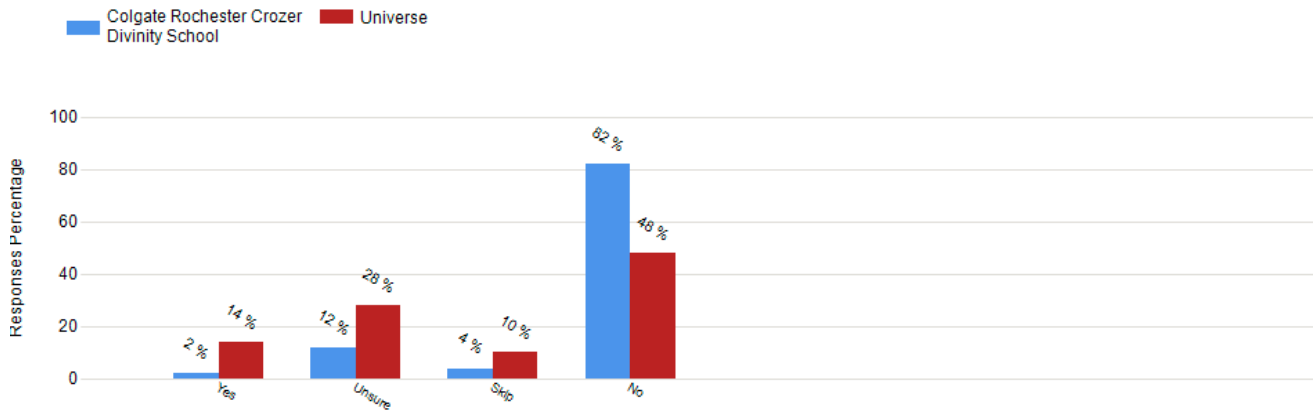
Do you think underage drinking is a problem at your school?

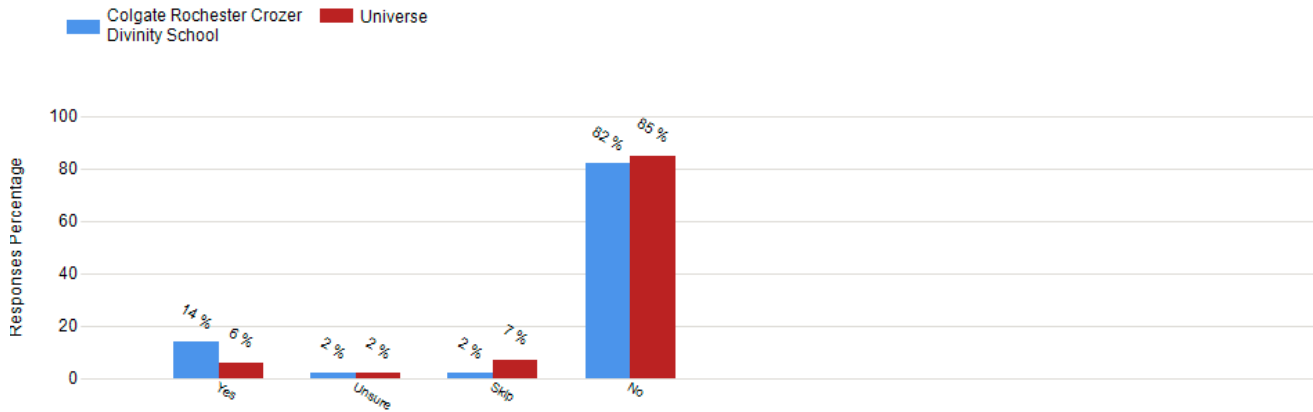

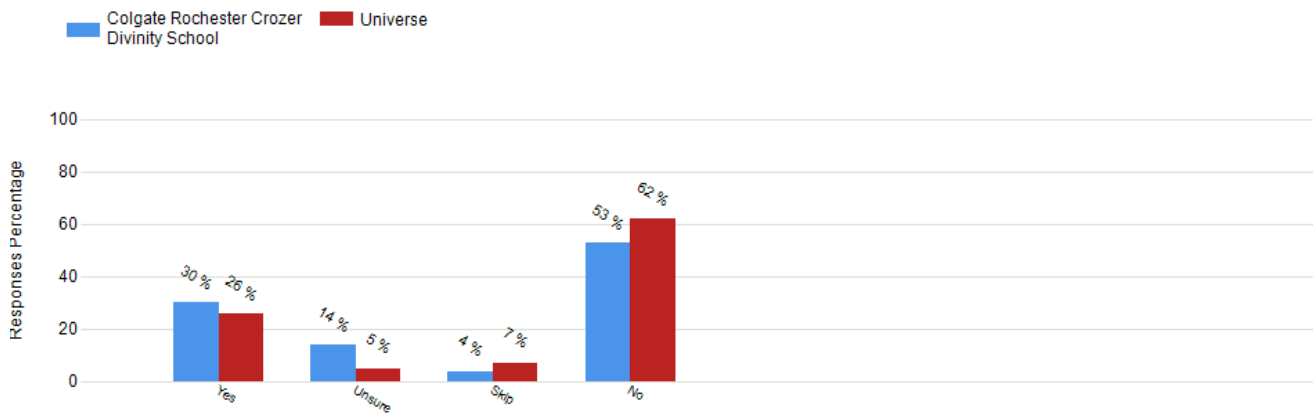
Have you ever felt harassed or bullied because of your sexual orientation or gender identity?

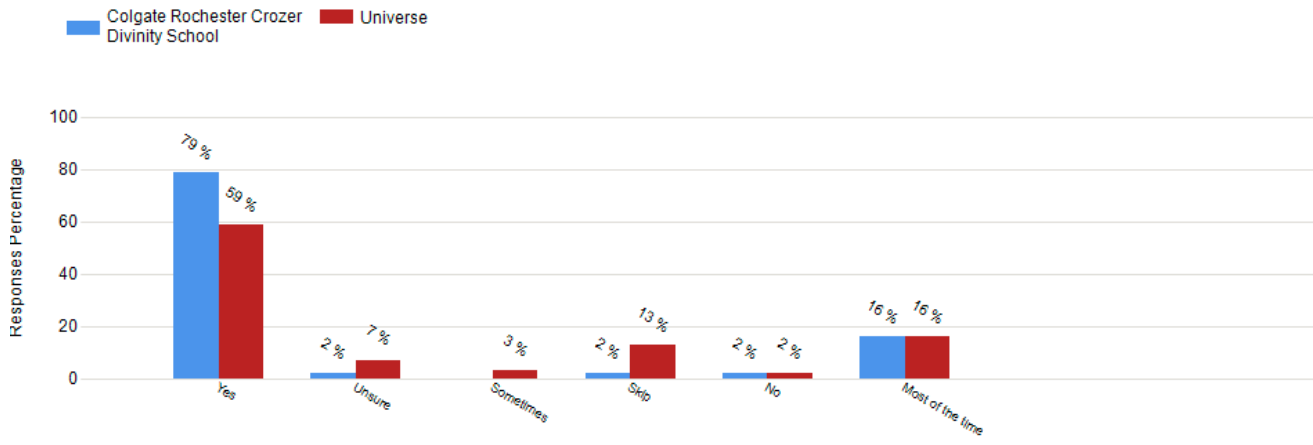

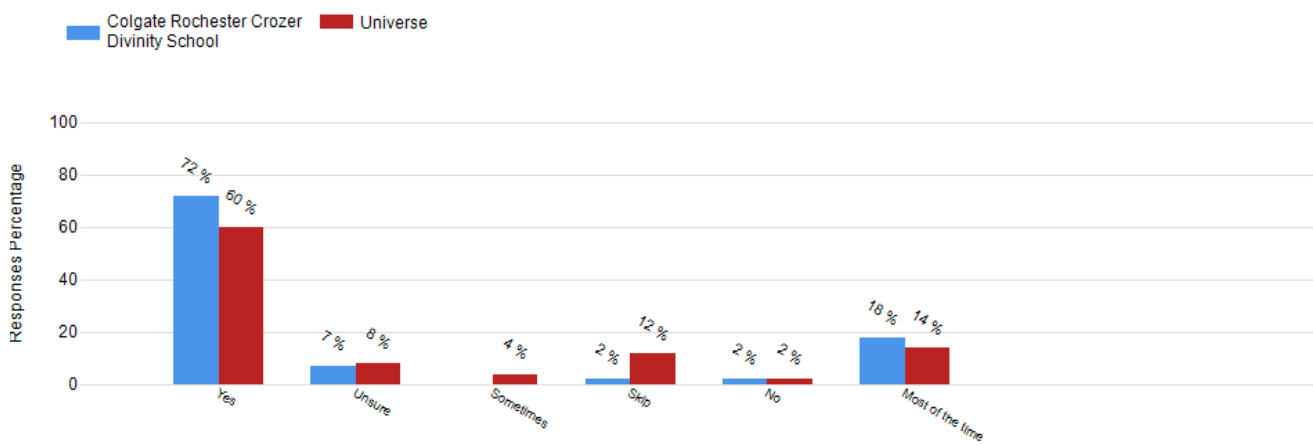
Do you feel that students are accepted and included at this school, regardless of their sexual orientation?

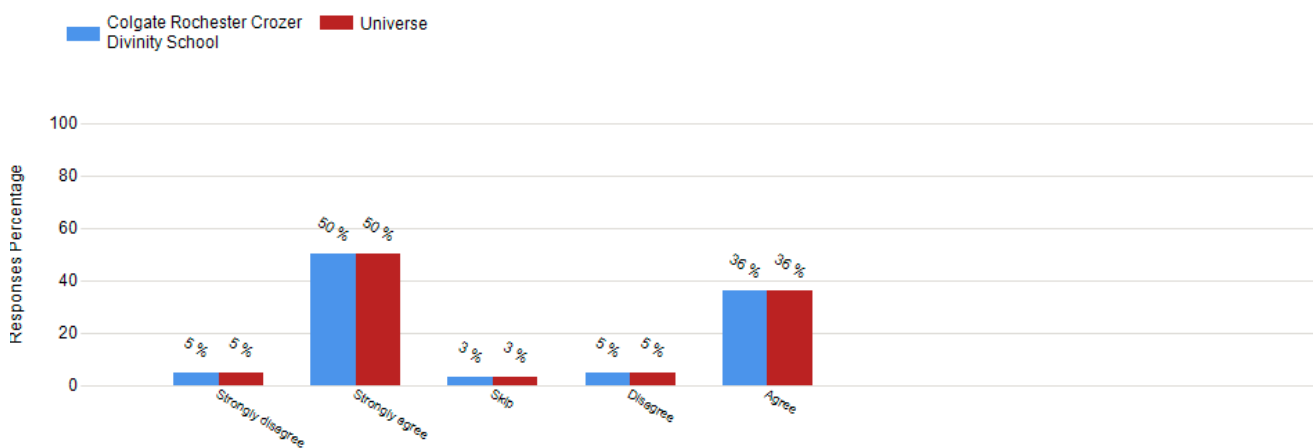

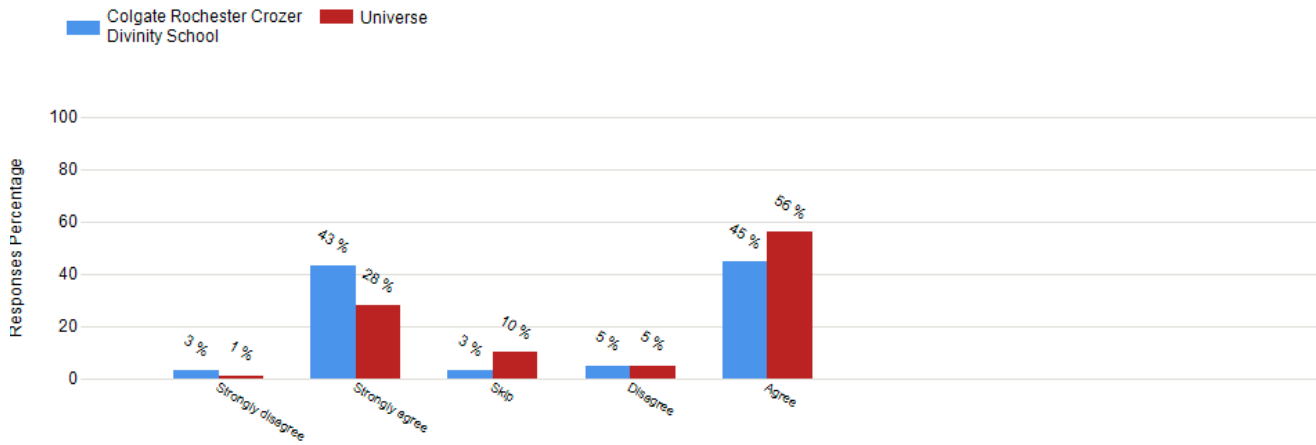
Students are valued in the classroom/learning environment.

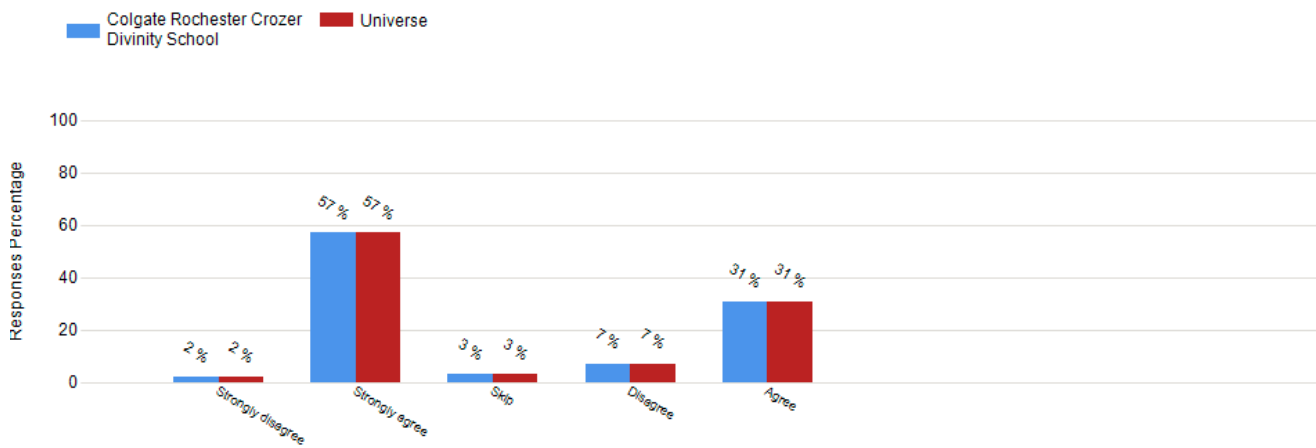

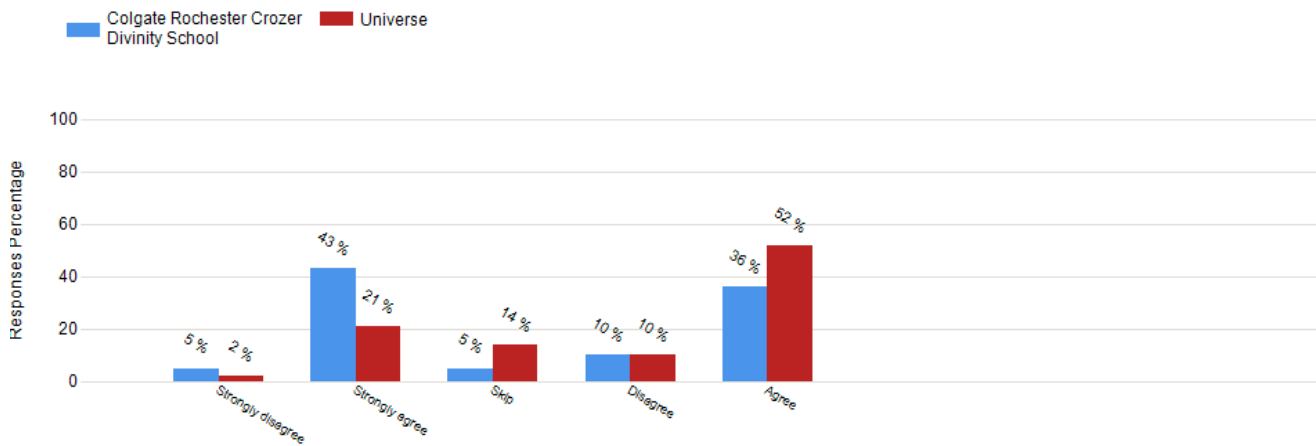

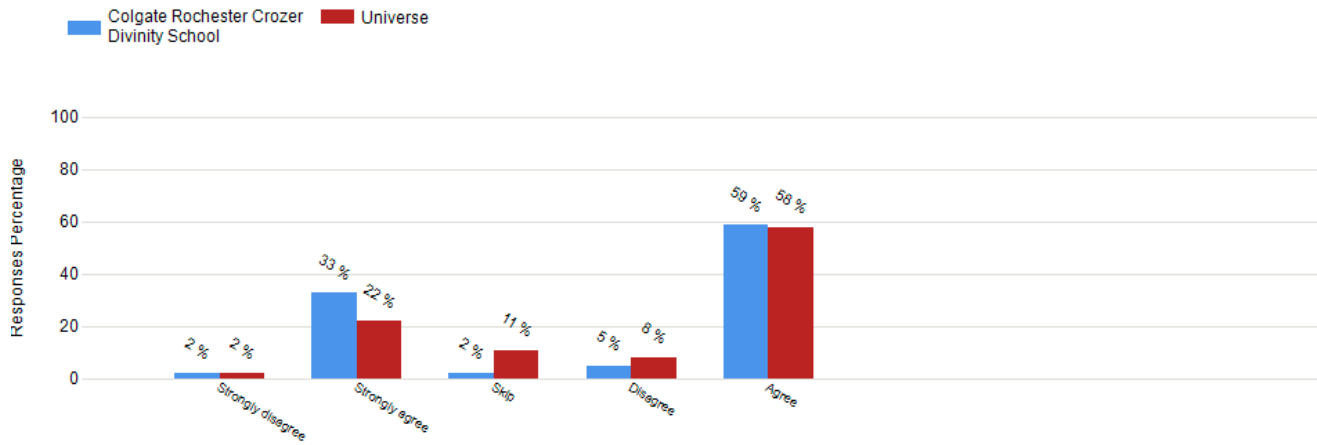

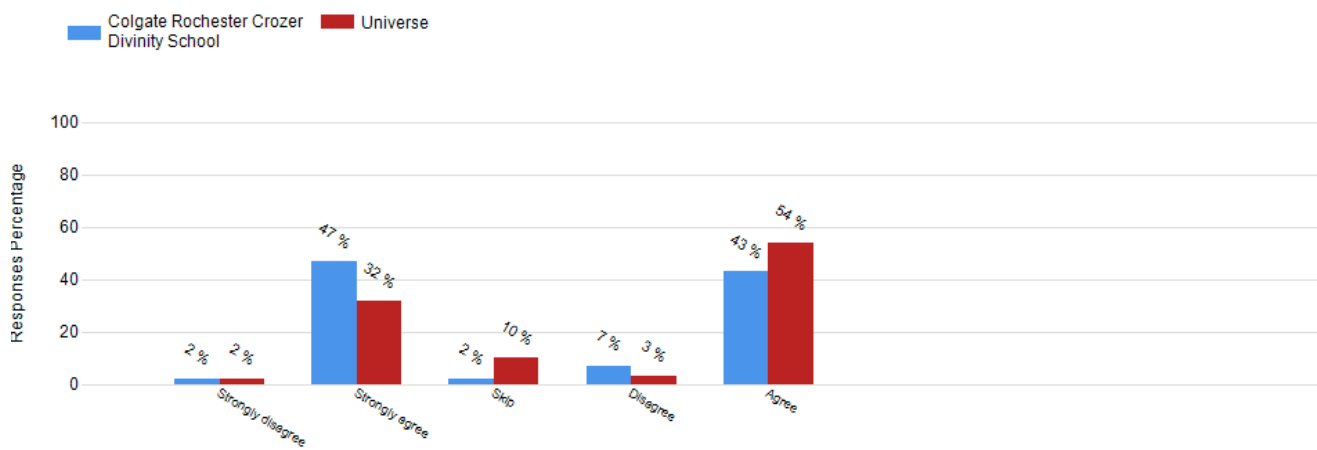

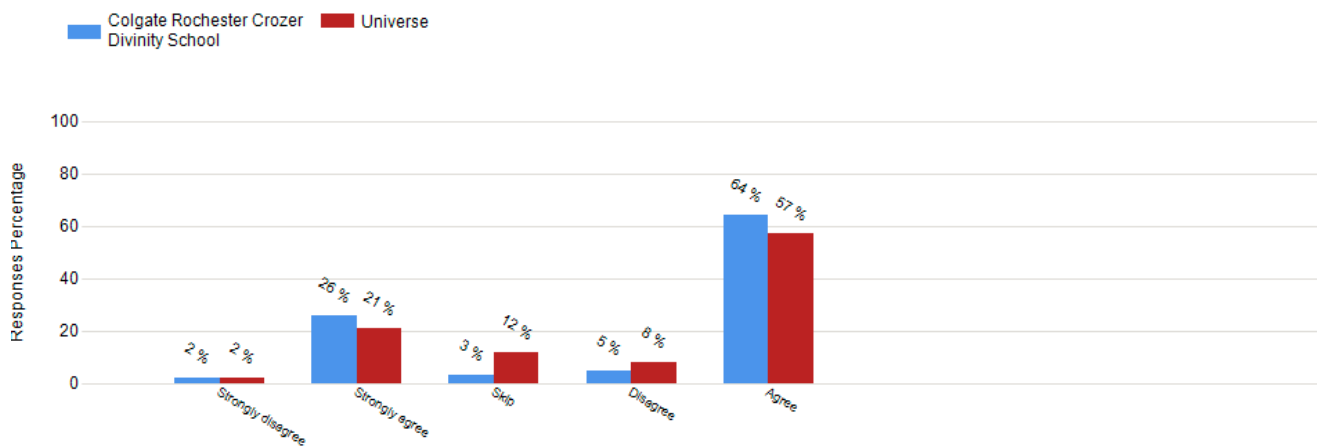

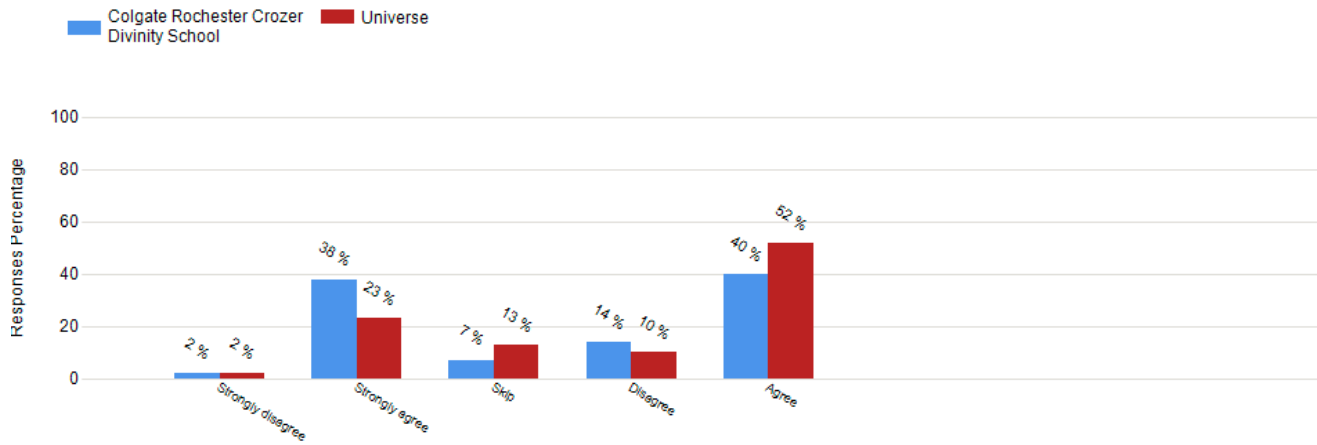

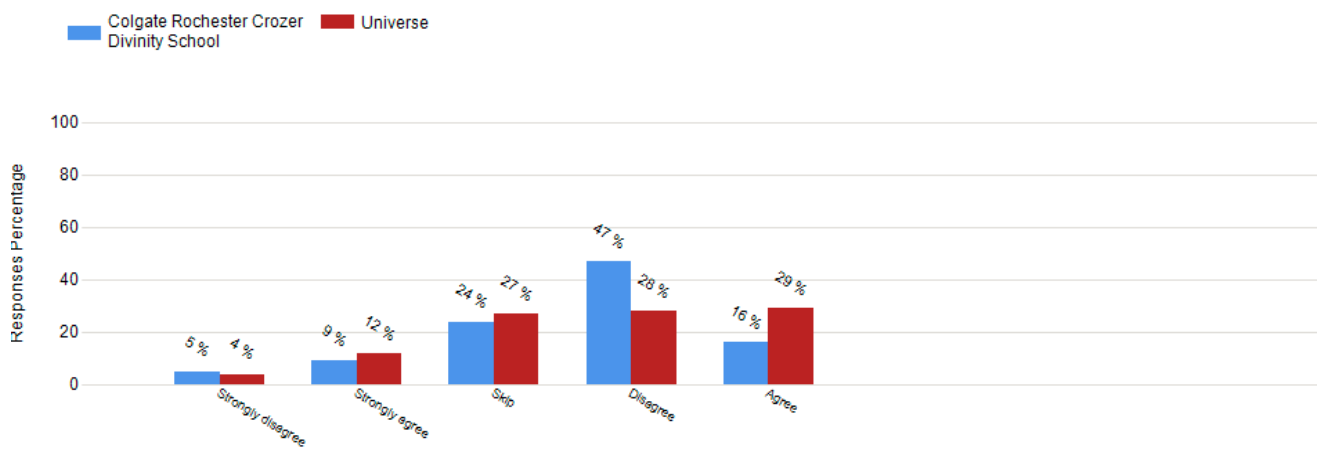

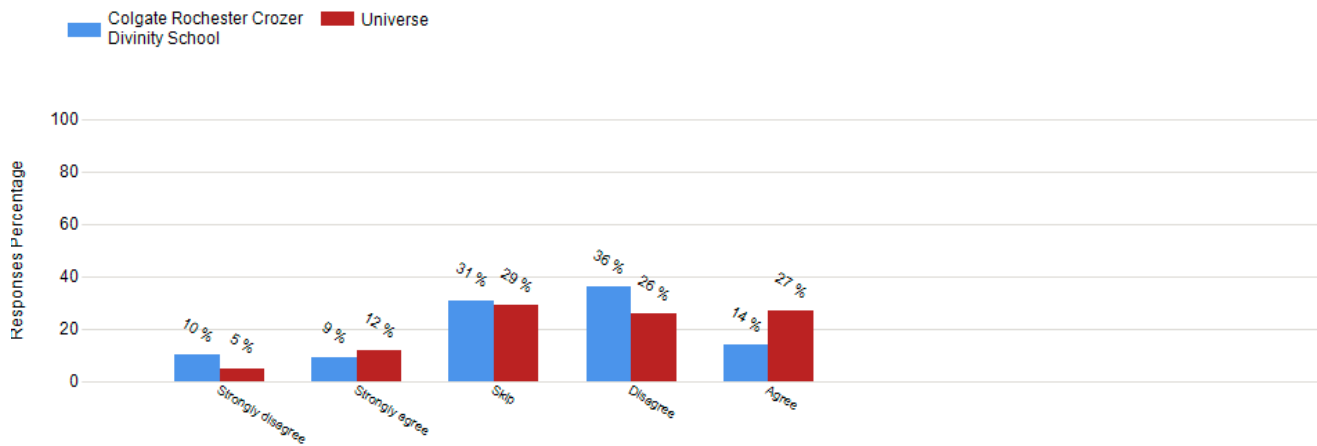

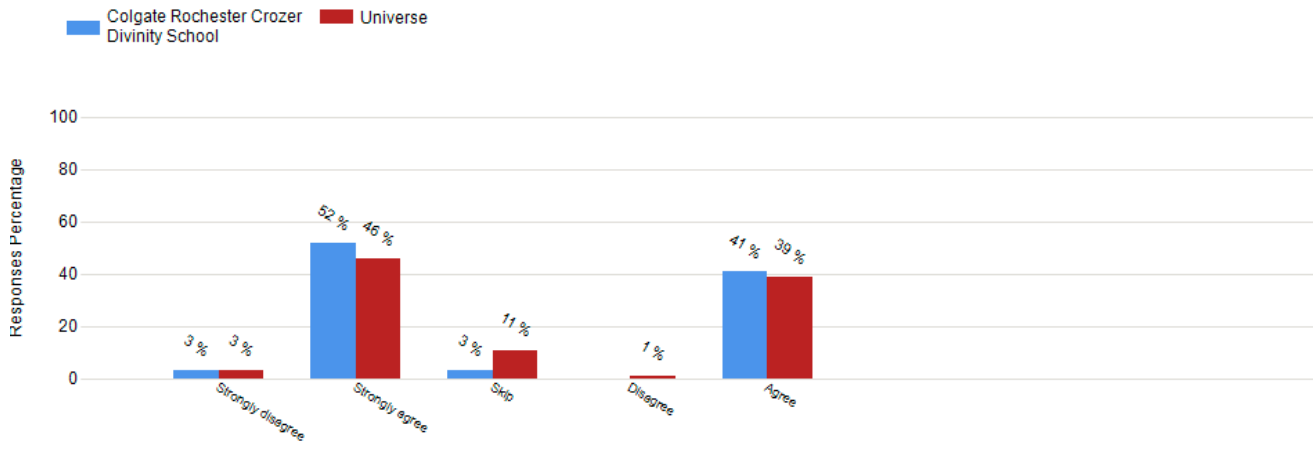

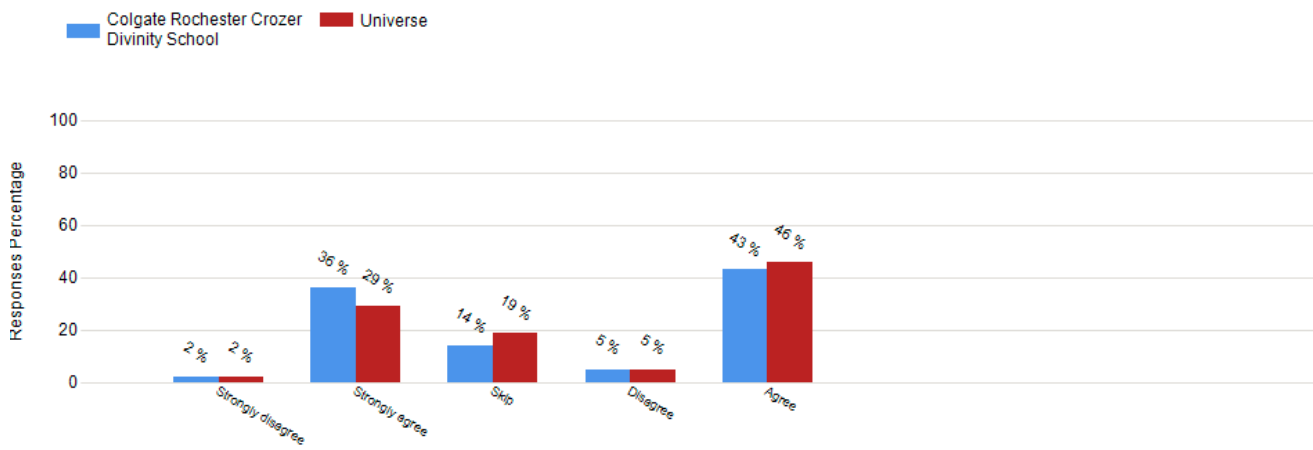

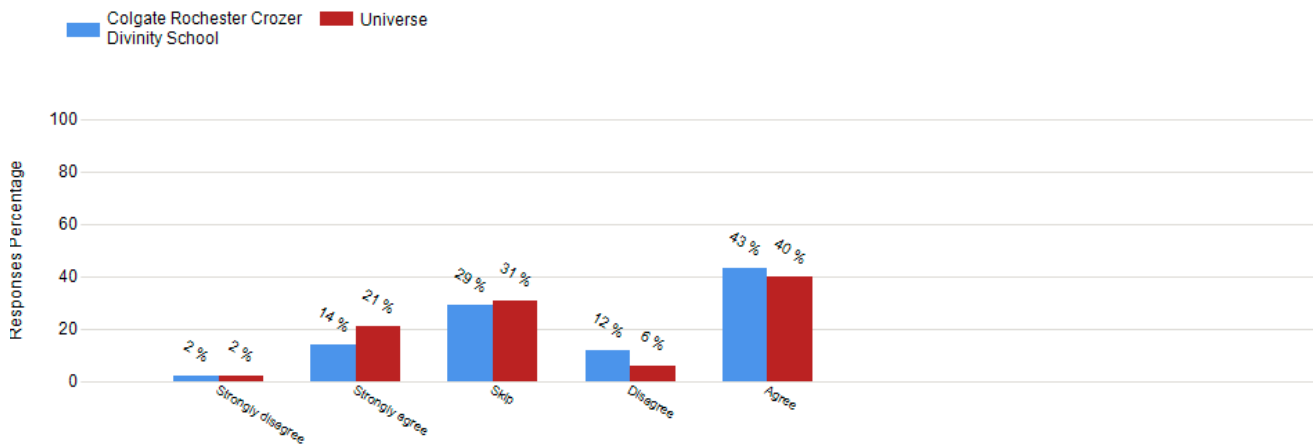

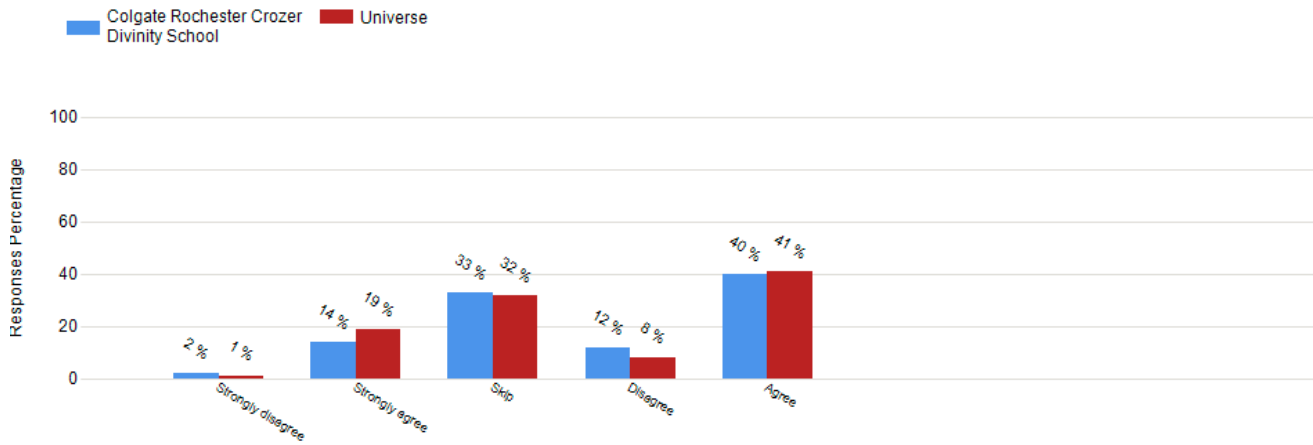

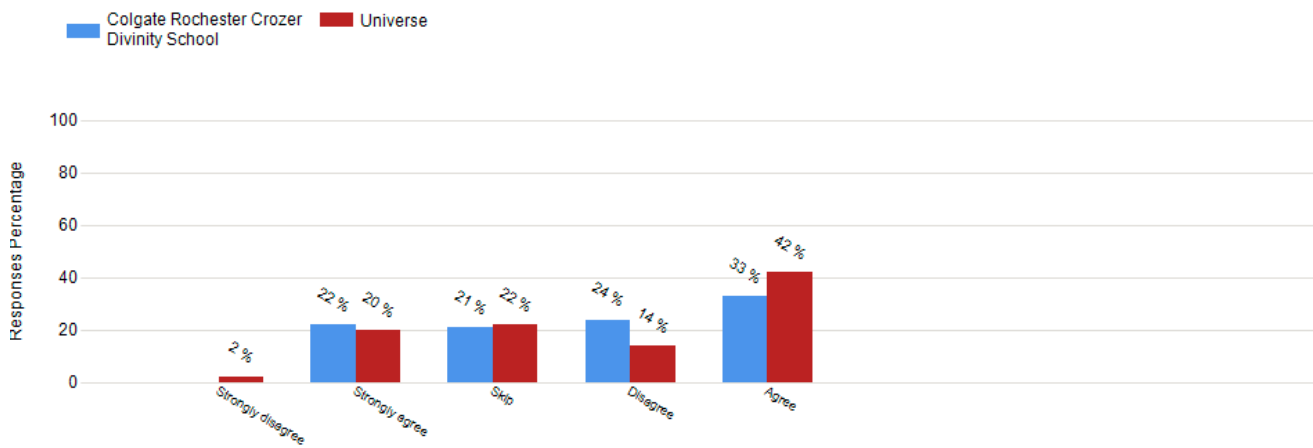

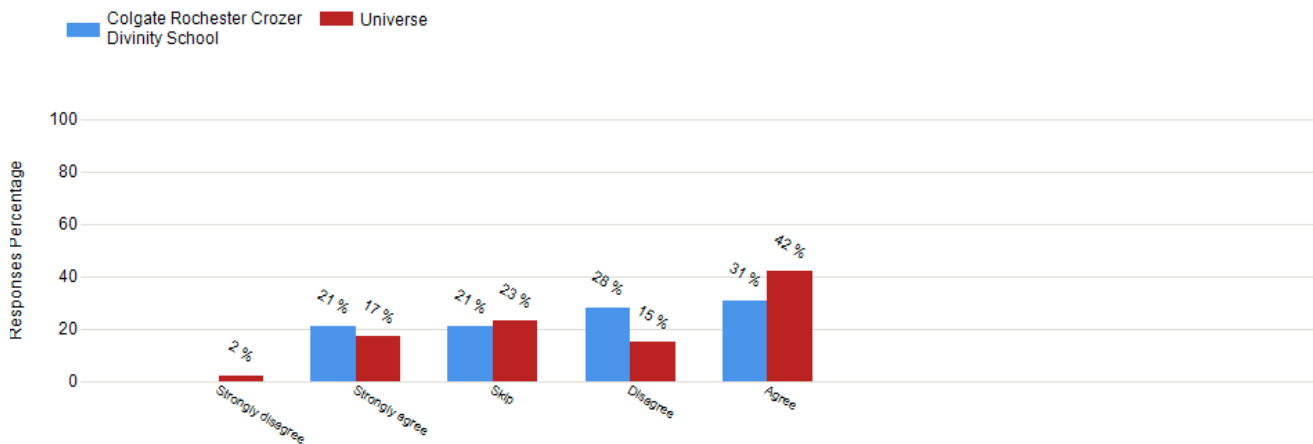

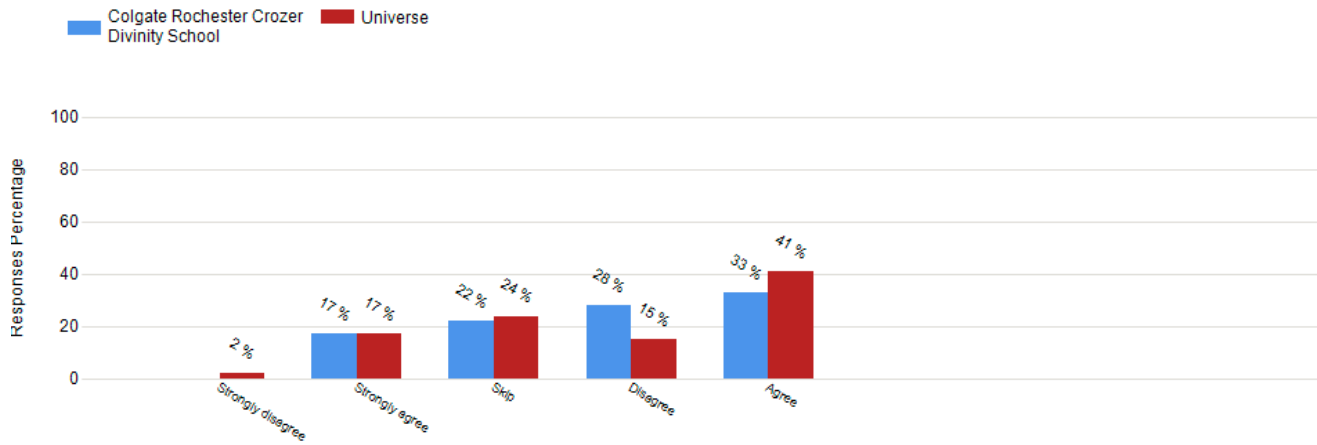

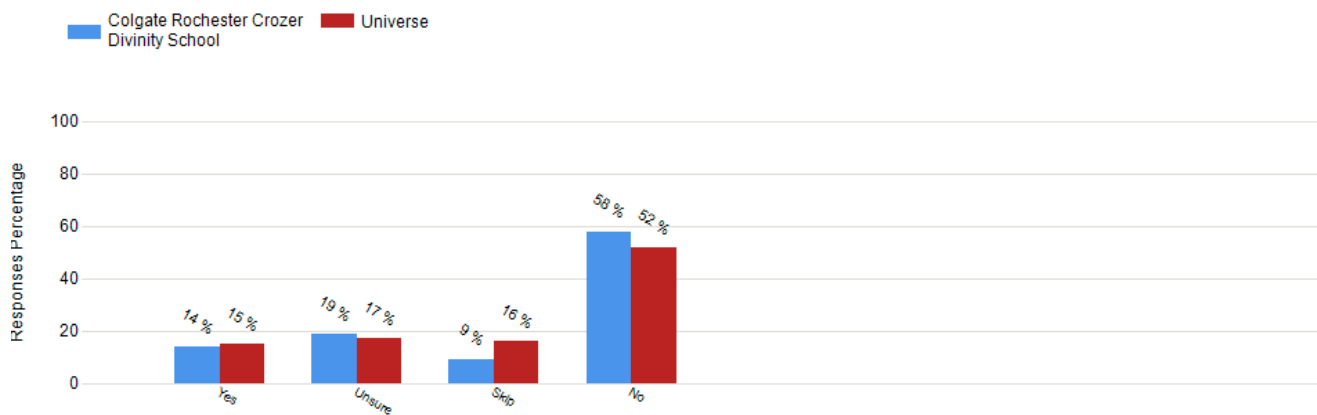
If you faced discrimination or harassment, do you know how to report the incident to the school?

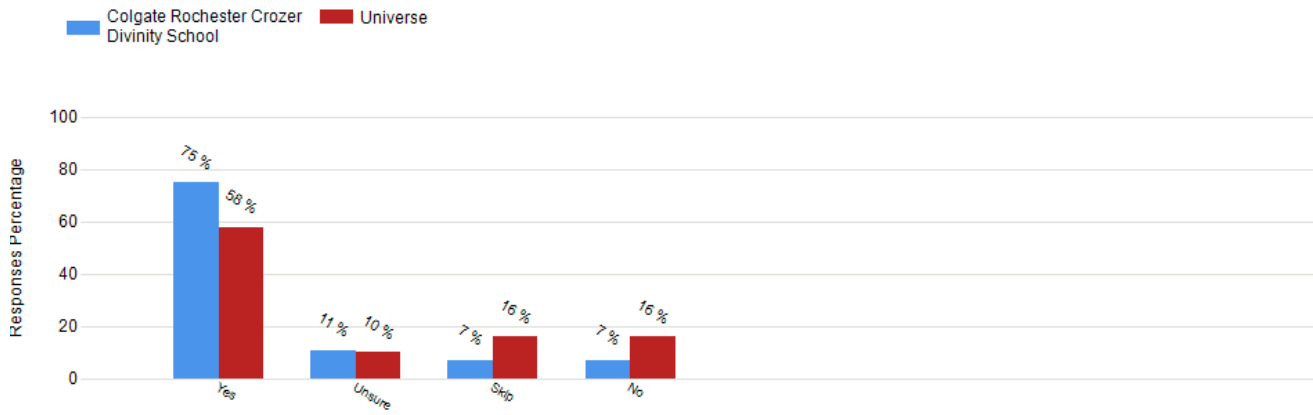
If you reported discrimination or harassment to the school, would you fear retaliation?

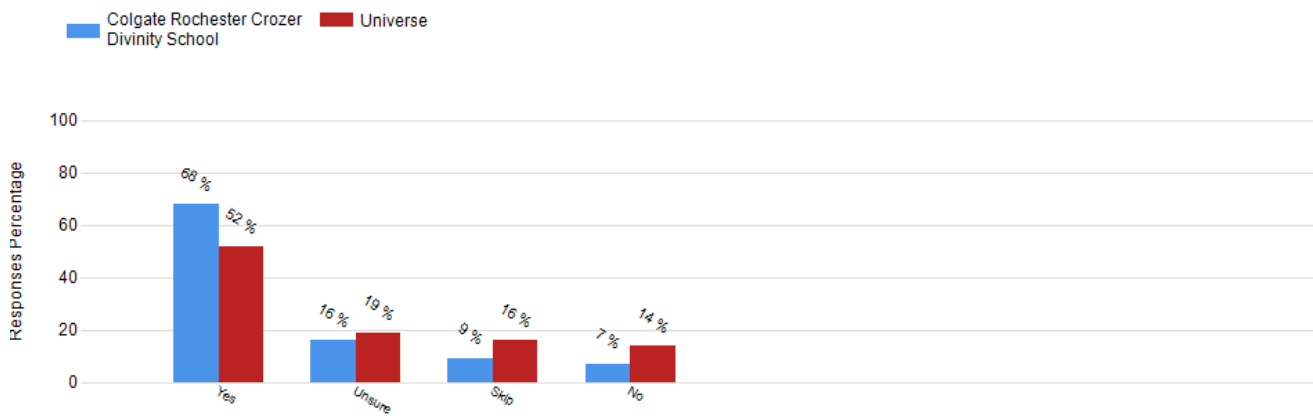
If you faced sexual assault, do you know how to report the incident to the school?

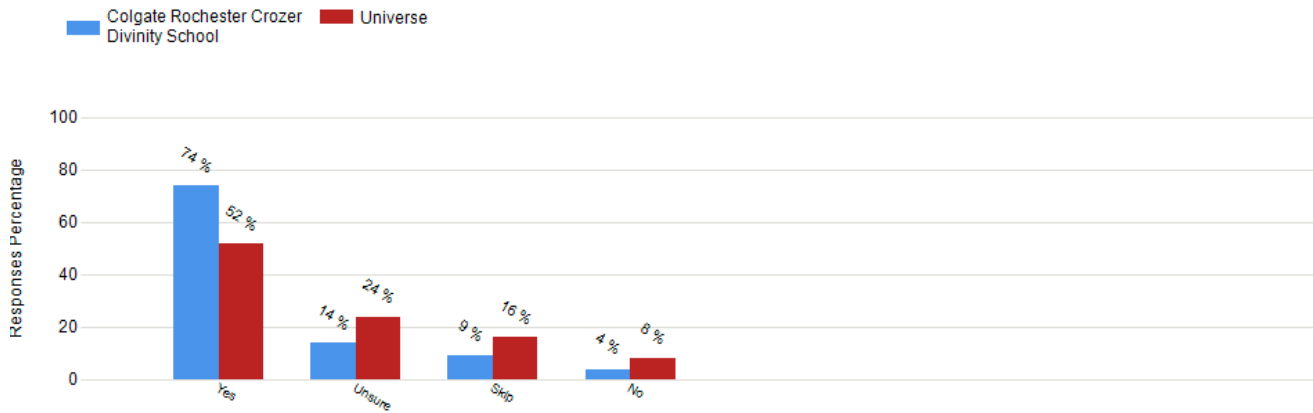
If you faced sexual assault, would you feel comfortable reporting the incident to the school?

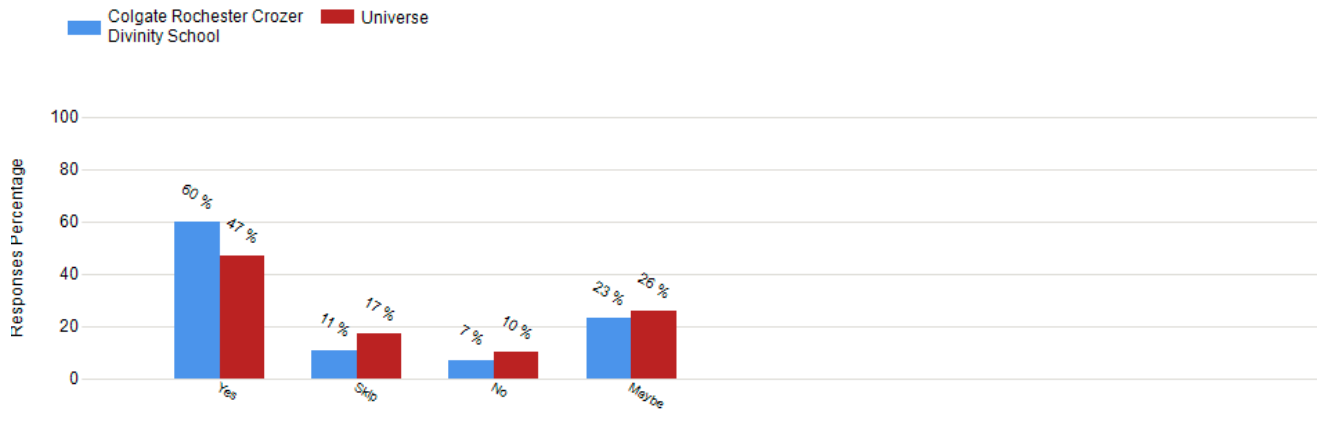
If you reported sexual assault to the school, do you think it would be taken seriously and investigated fairly?

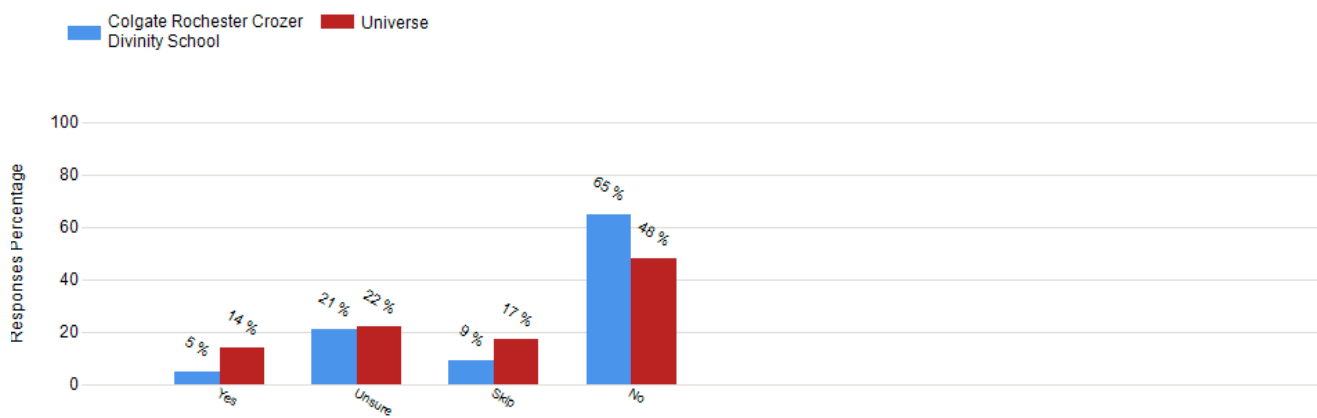
If you faced sexual assault, would you feel comfortable utilizing school resources?

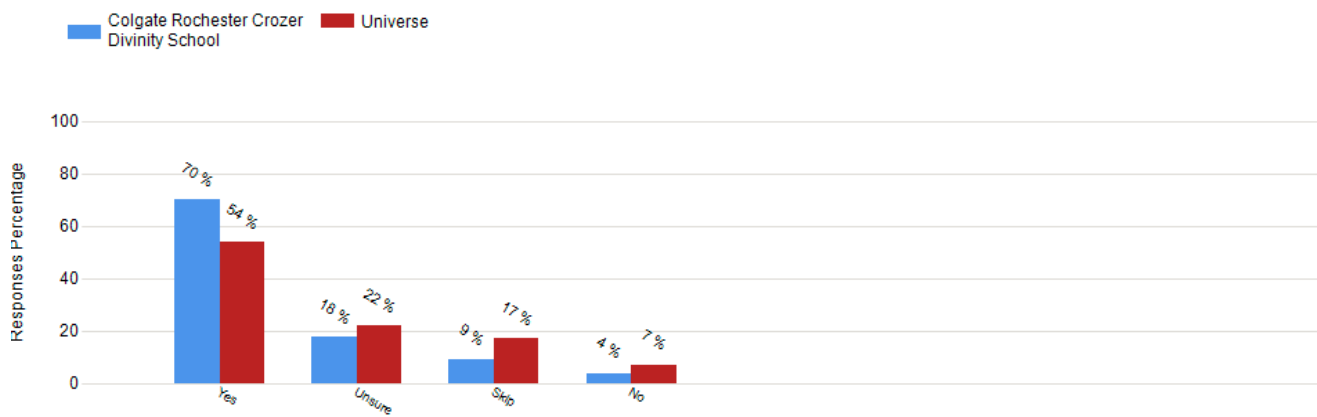
If you reported sexual assault to the school, would you fear retaliation?

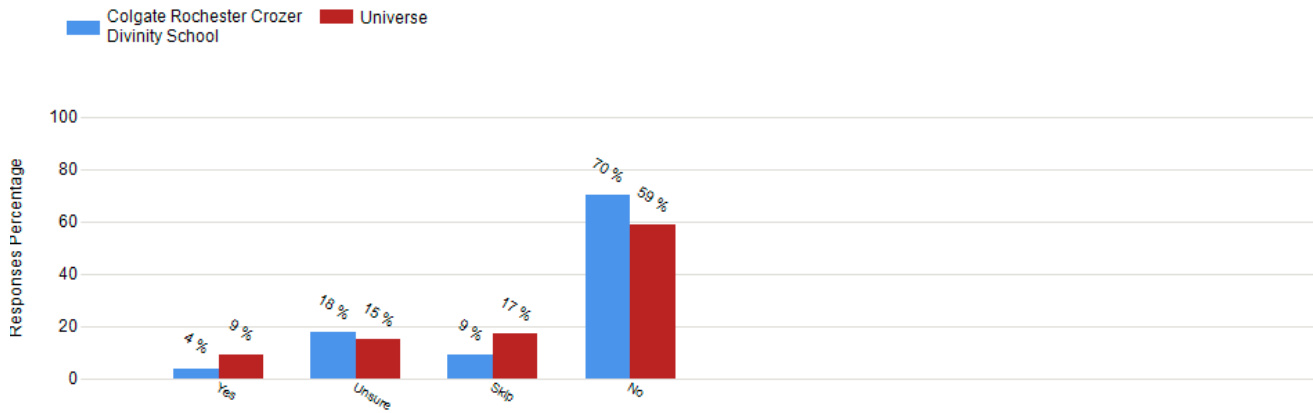

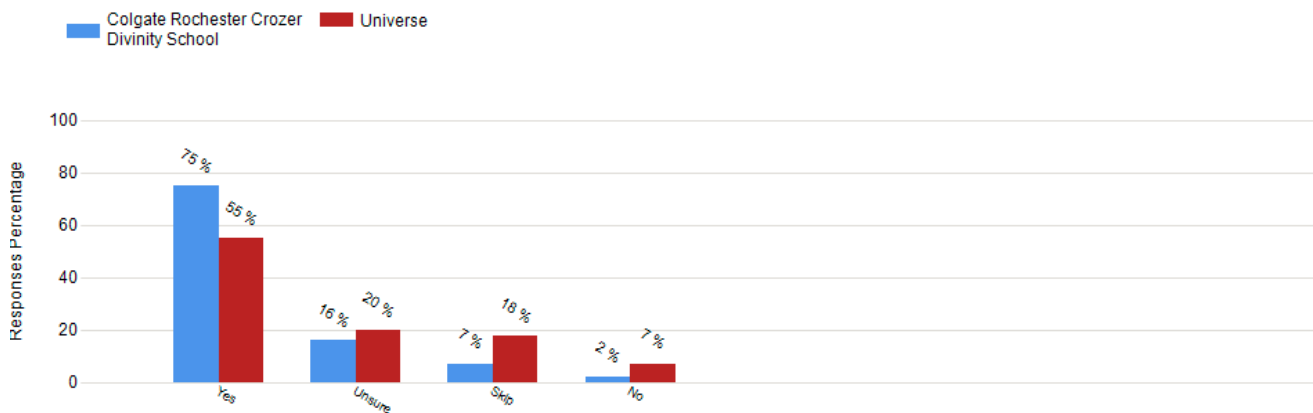

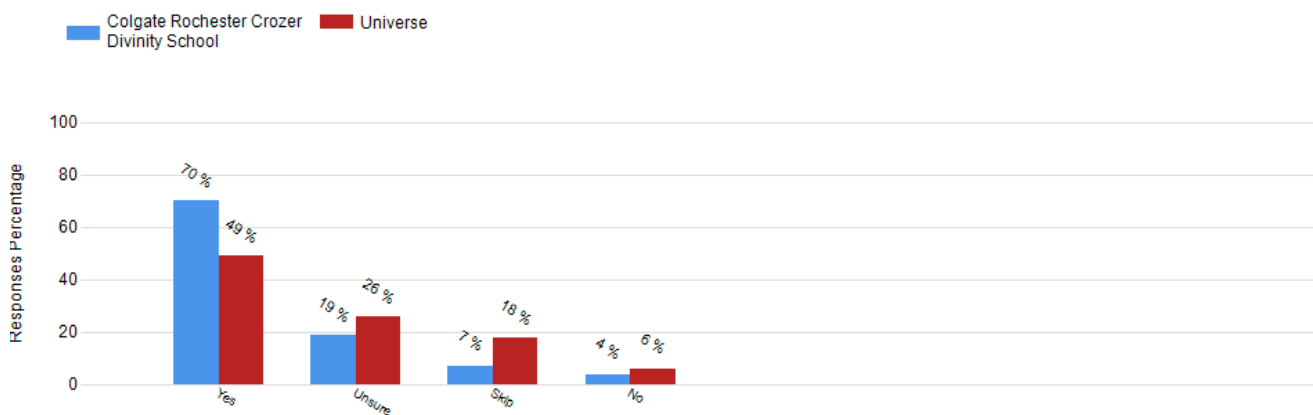

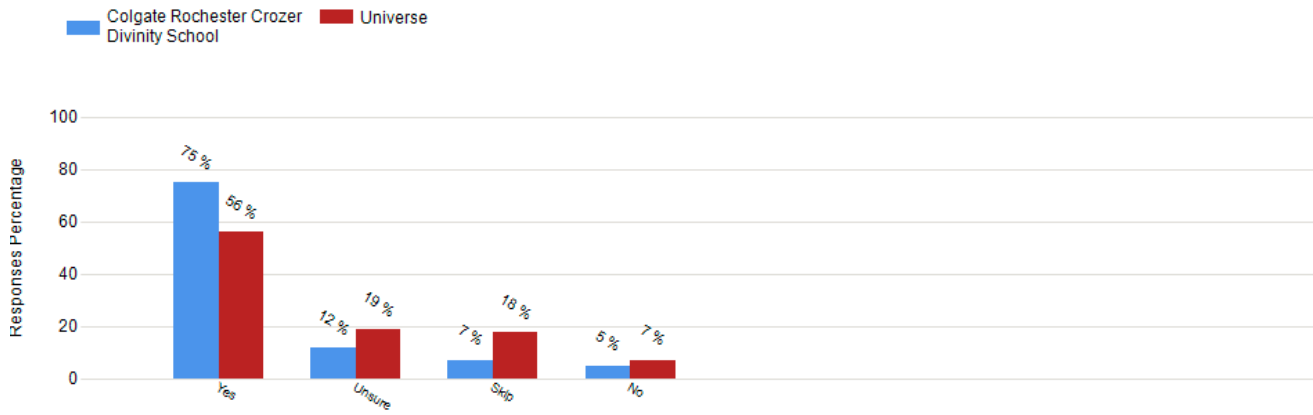

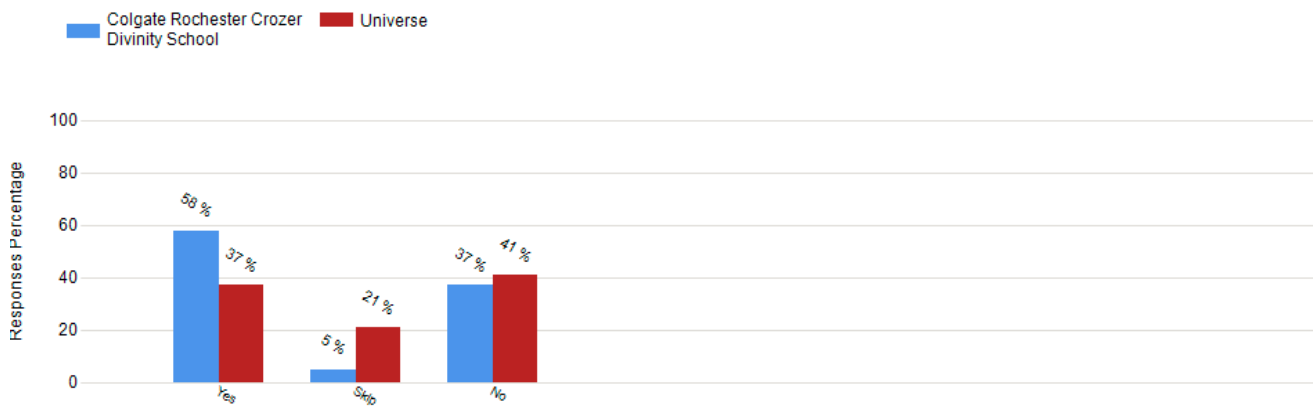

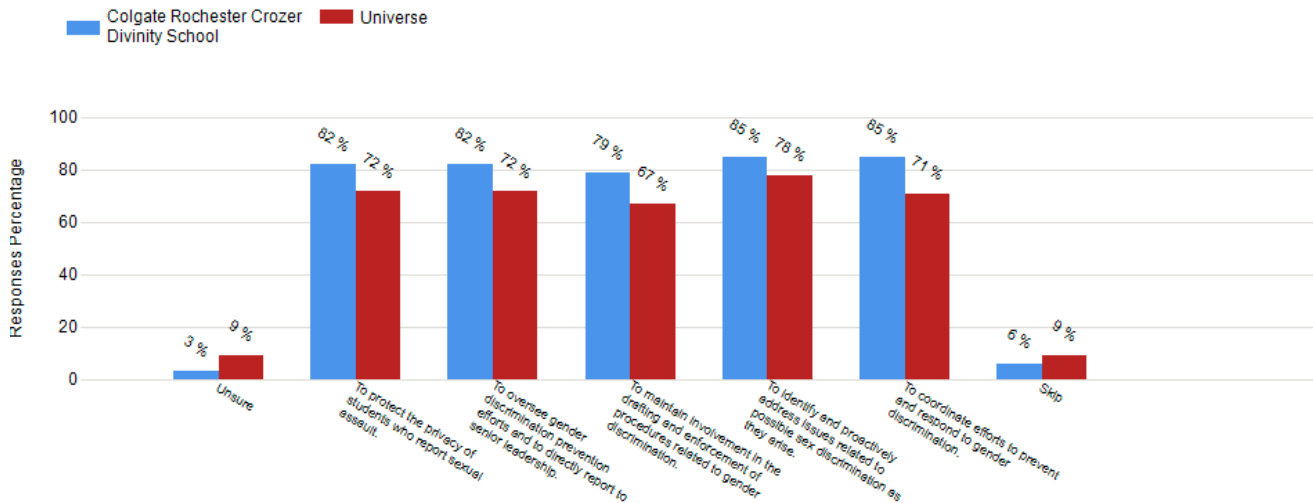
Do you know what a Title IX Coordinator is?

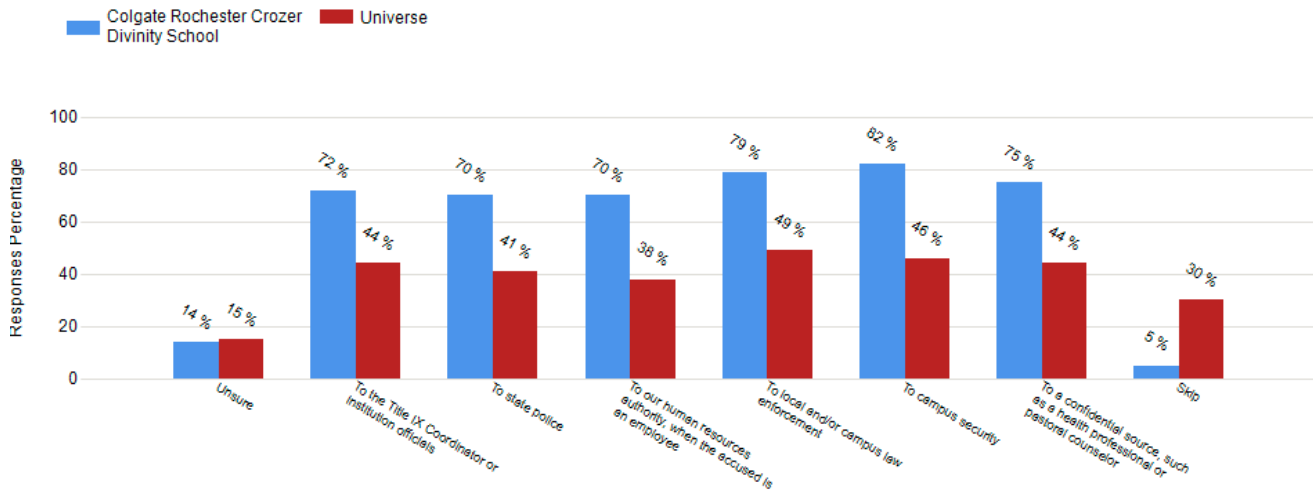
What are the roles of a Title IX Coordinator at your institution? [Choose all that apply.]

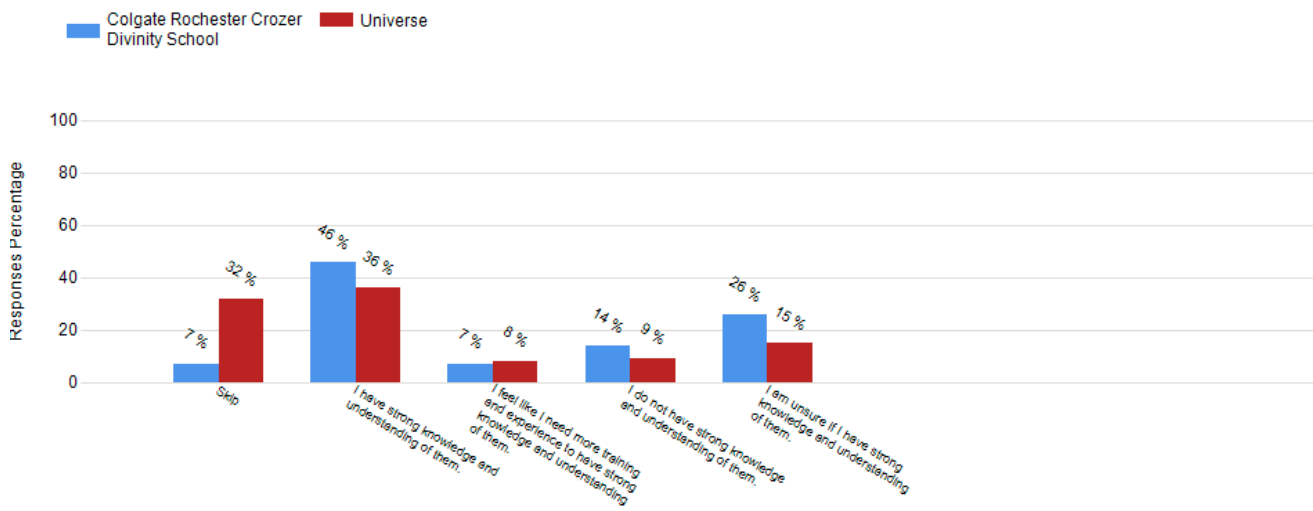
To which of the following entities may a survivor or witness of sexual assault, dating violence, stalking or domestic violence file a report? [Choose all that apply]

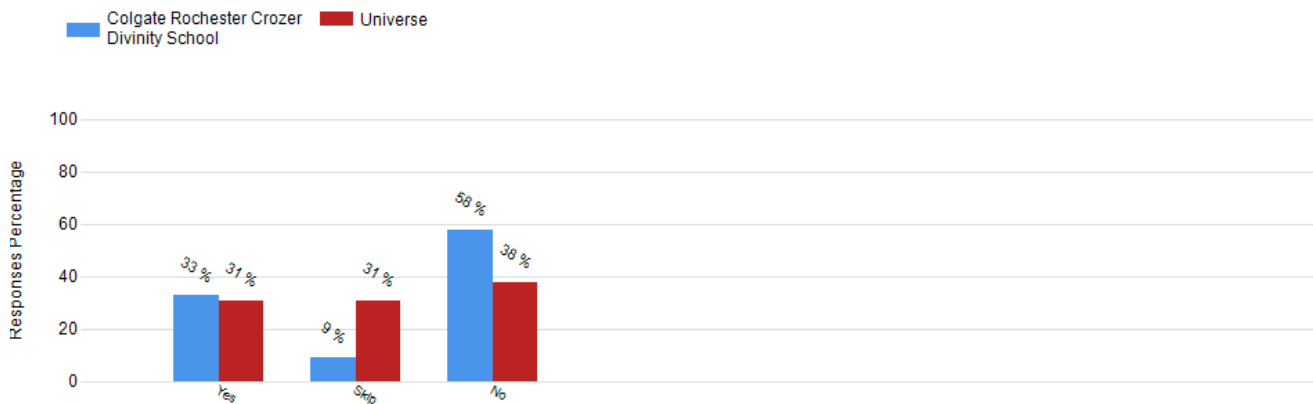

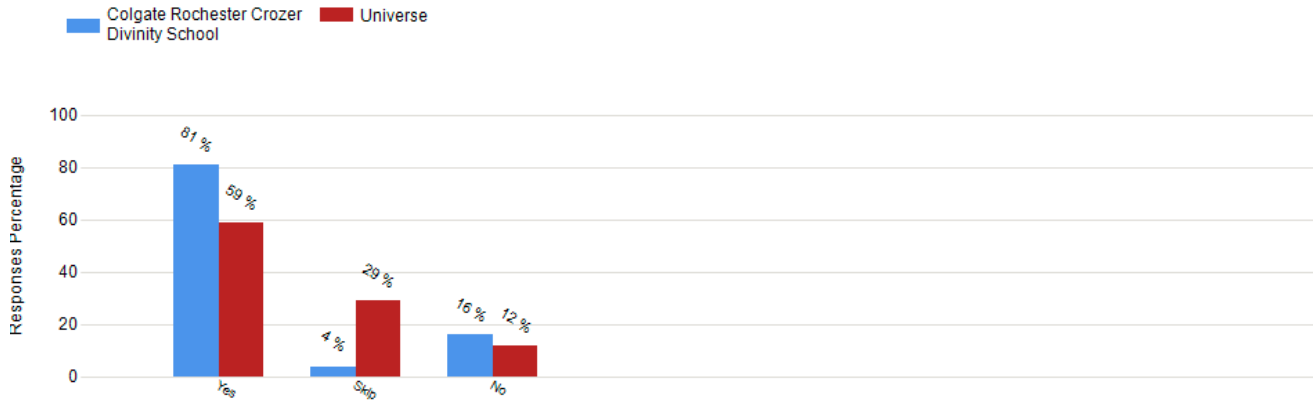
In conducting an investigation at our institution, do you know what standard we use to determine if sexual conduct is consensual?

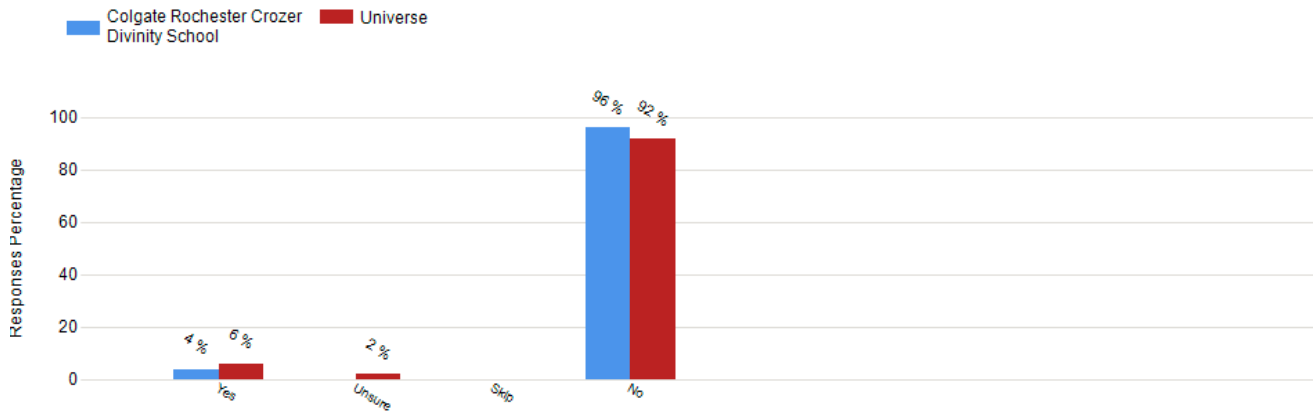

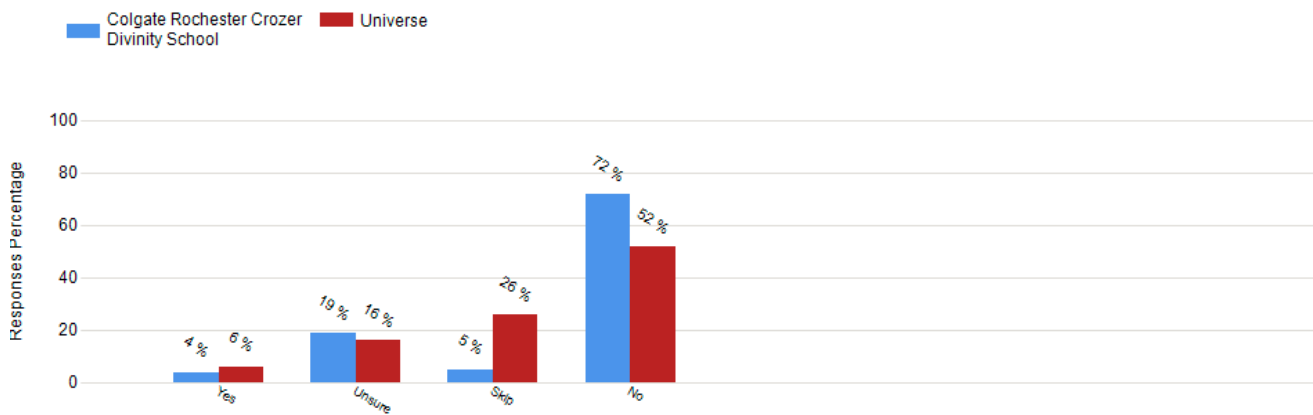

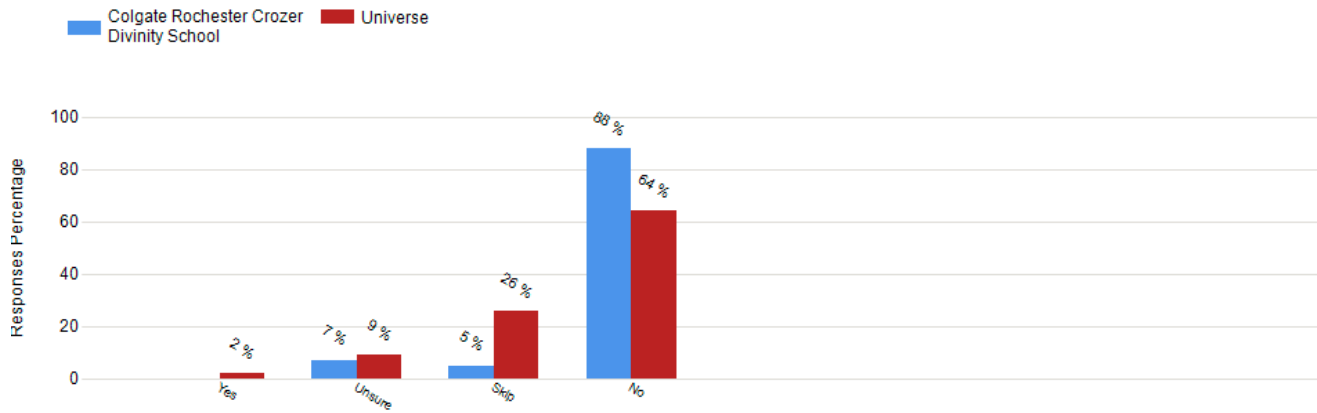

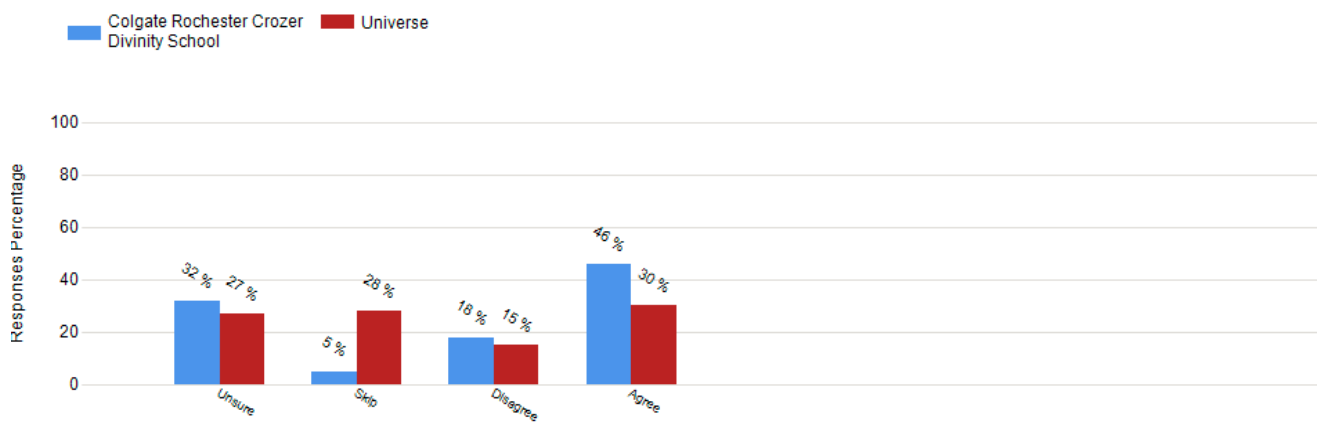

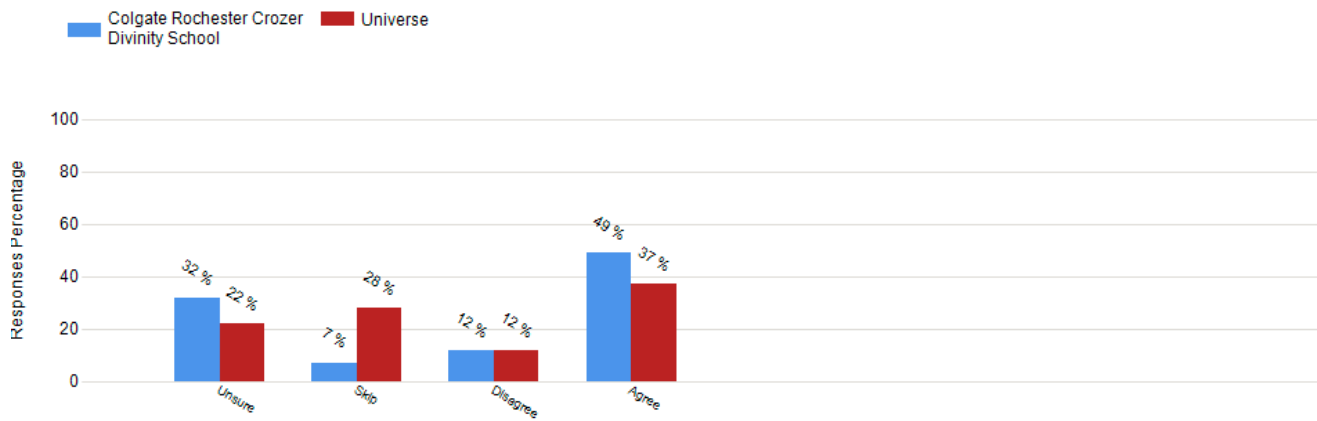
The criminal law may have a different standard of proof than our institutional policies.

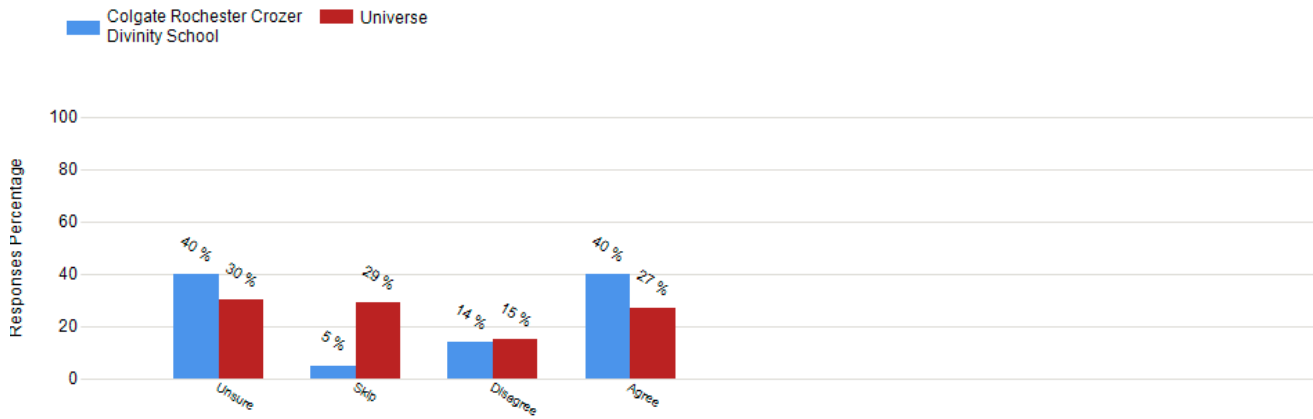
The criminal law may require different evidence than institutional policies.

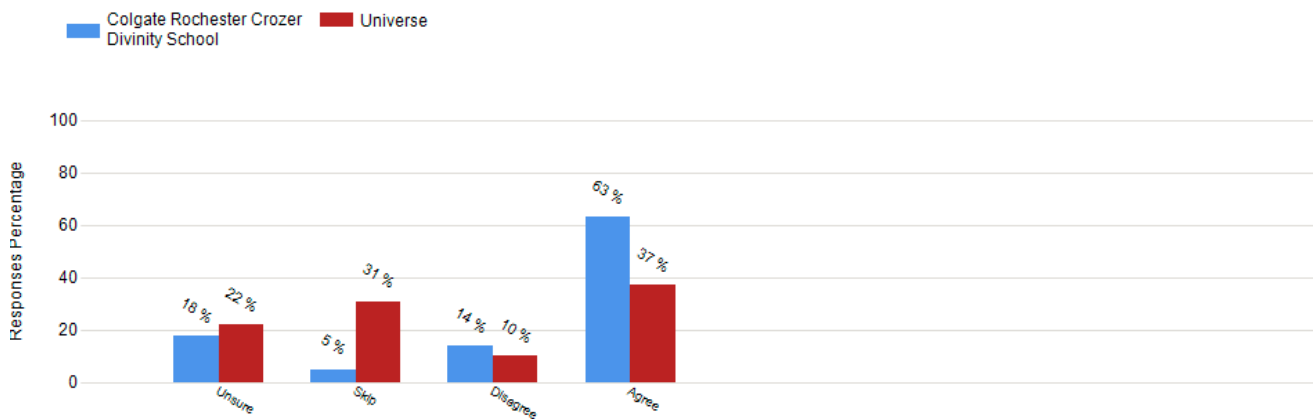
The criminal law may require exclusion of certain evidence that institutional policies would not exclude.

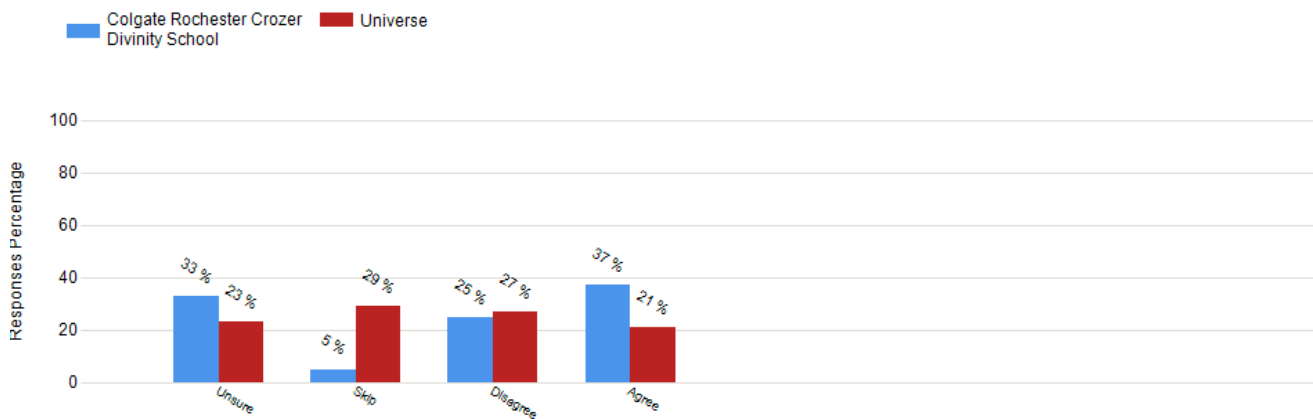
Student conduct actions are governed by the institutional policies while criminal actions are governed by the criminal law and law of criminal procedure.

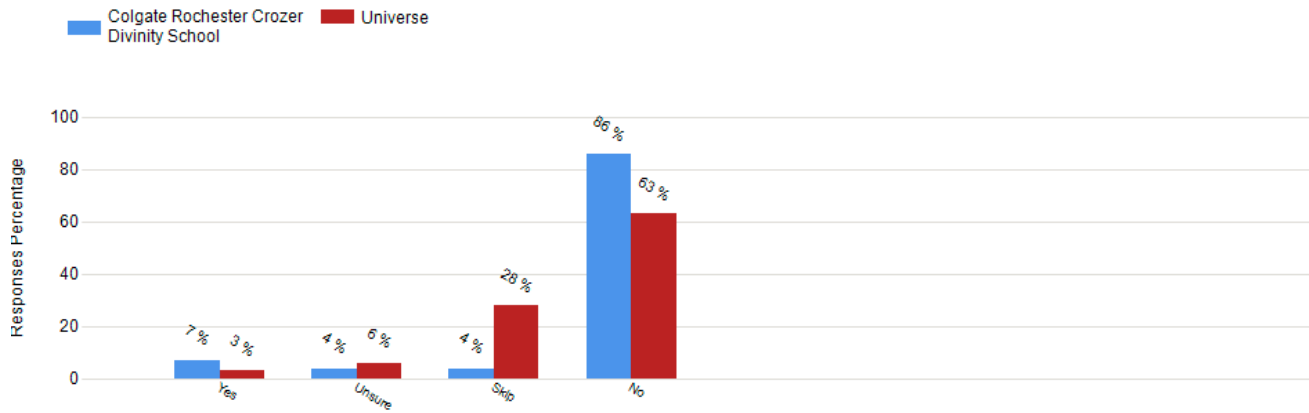
Sexual contact that lacks affirmative consent violates institutional policy but may not necessarily violate the criminal law.

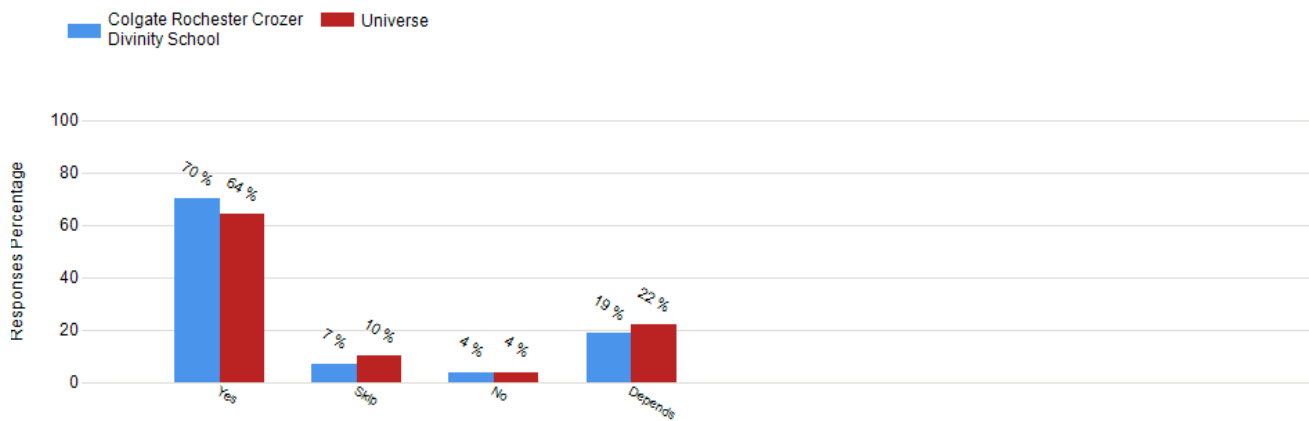

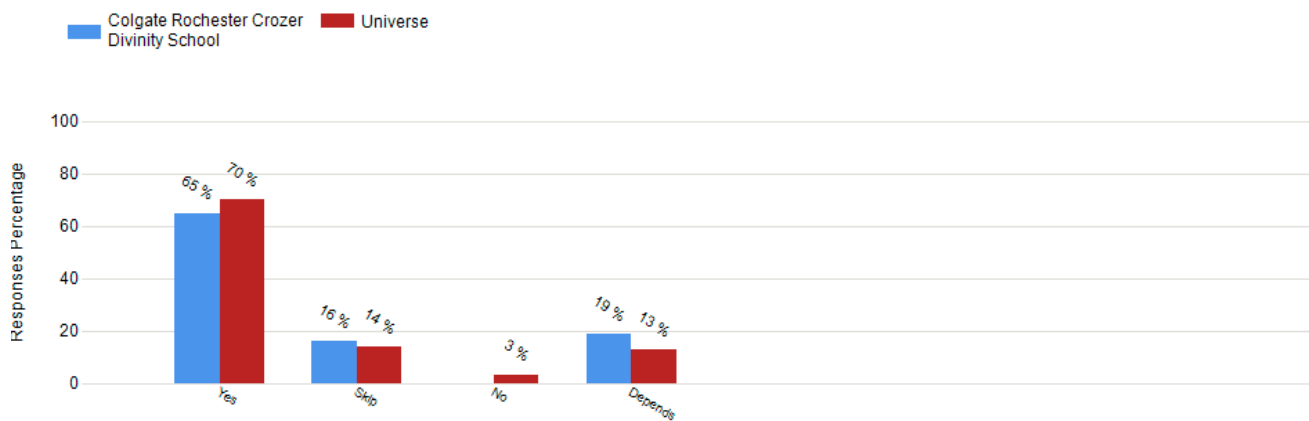
Do you think it's important to share sexual history with someone before becoming sexually active with them?

If you choose to be sexually active, do you think it's important to use a form of birth control besides birth control pills?

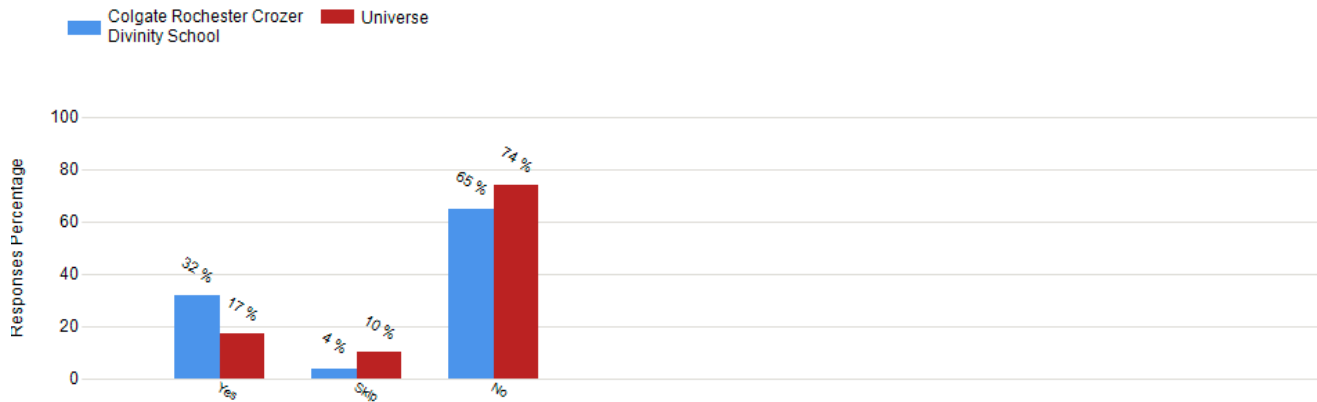

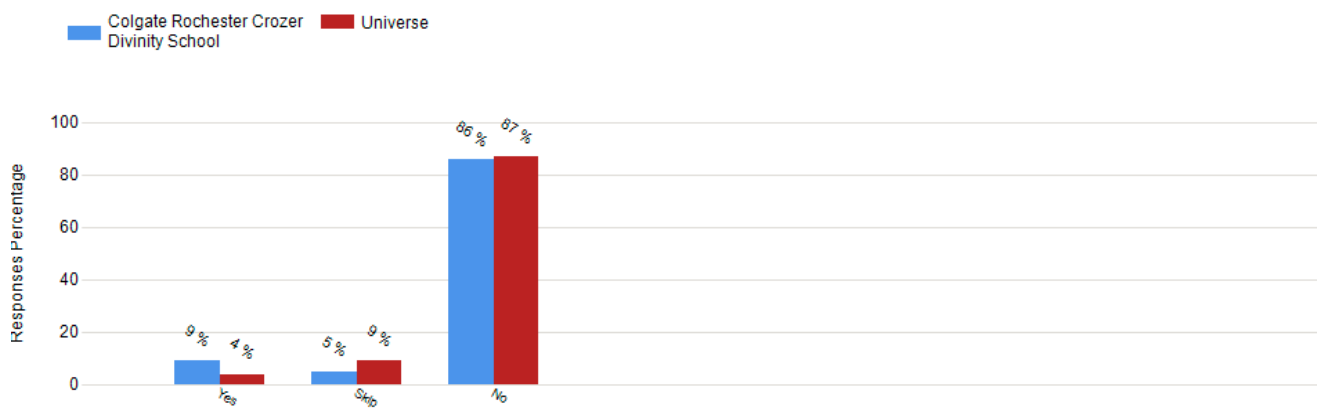
Have you, or someone you know, faced unwanted sexual conduct?

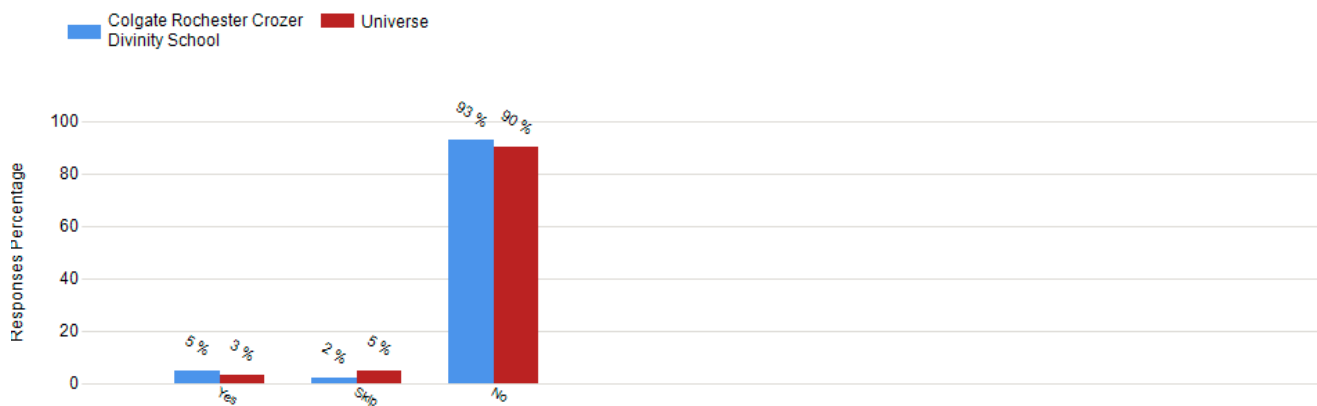
Have you faced sexual assault?

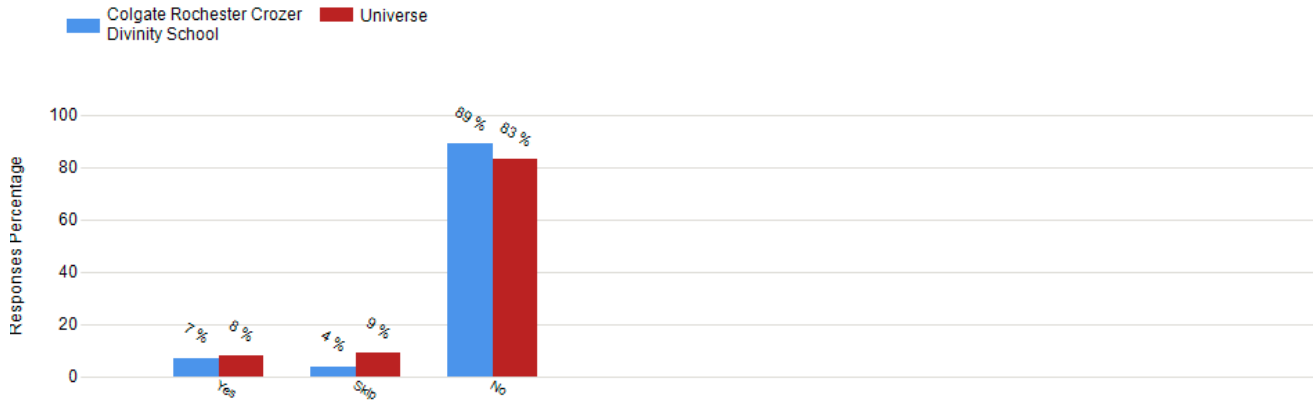
Have you ever been threatened with physical violence against you or someone you love if you didn't engage in sexual conduct?

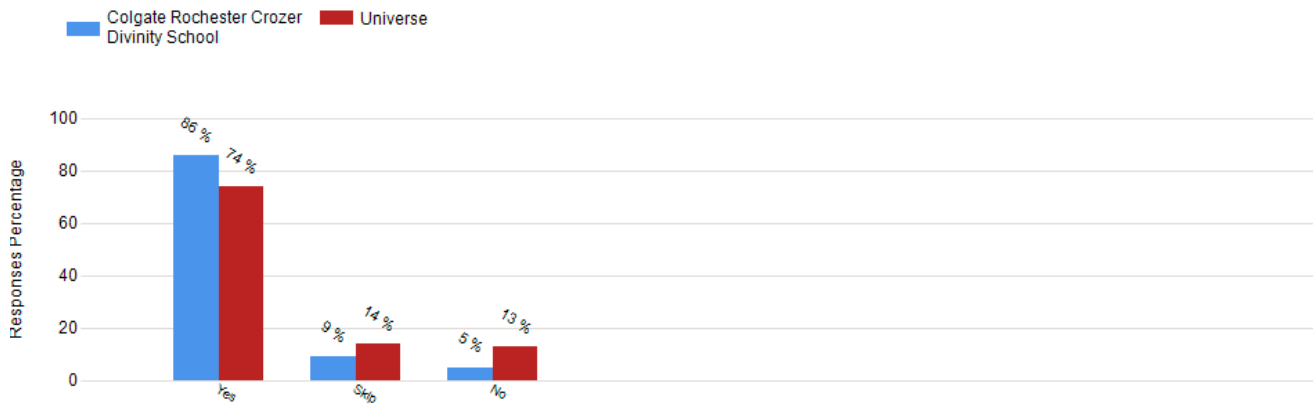
Has anyone succeeded in engaging in sexual contact with you by using violence or the threat of violence?

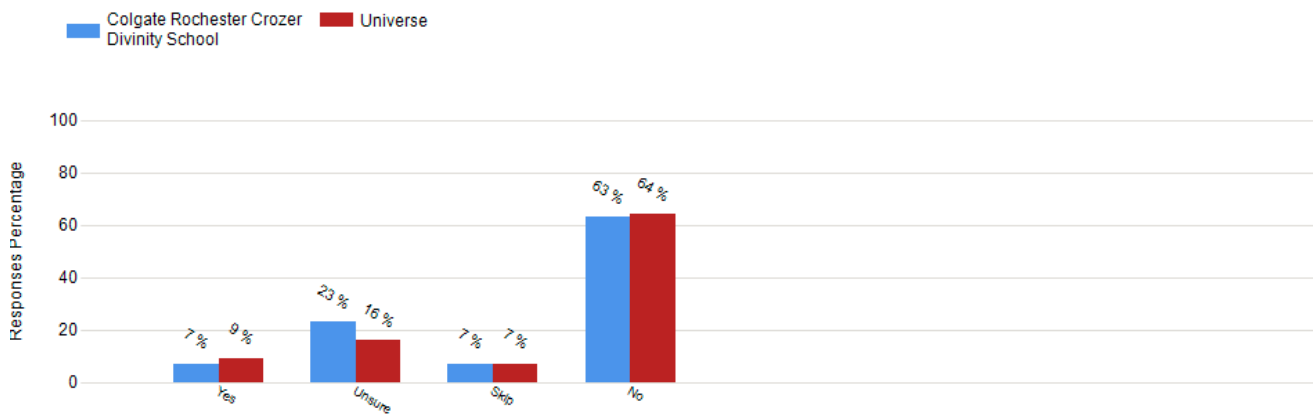
Do you think it's important to receive verbal consent before every sexual encounter, even with someone you've had a consensual sexual encounter with in the past?

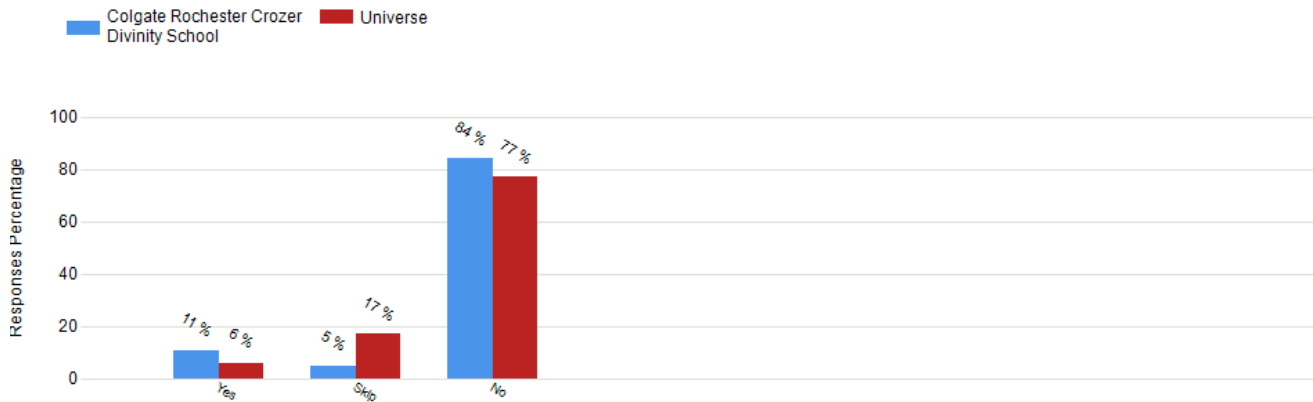

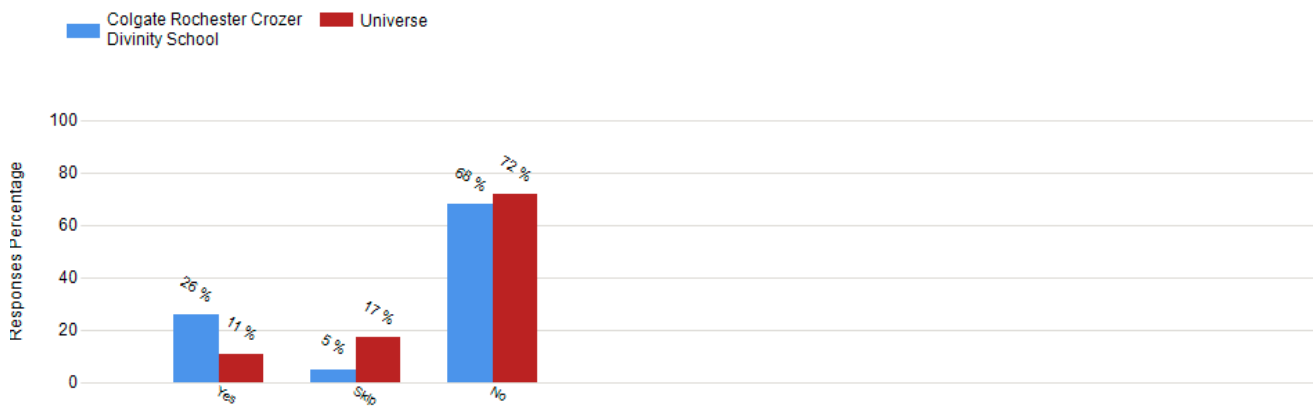
Have you, or someone you know, faced unwanted, repeated conduct by someone you didn't know?

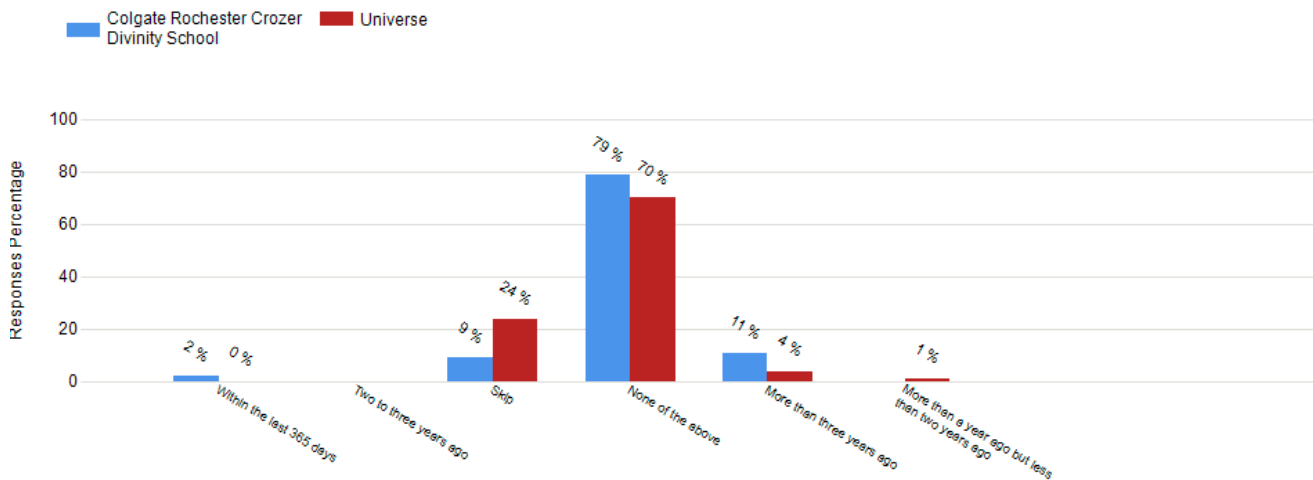

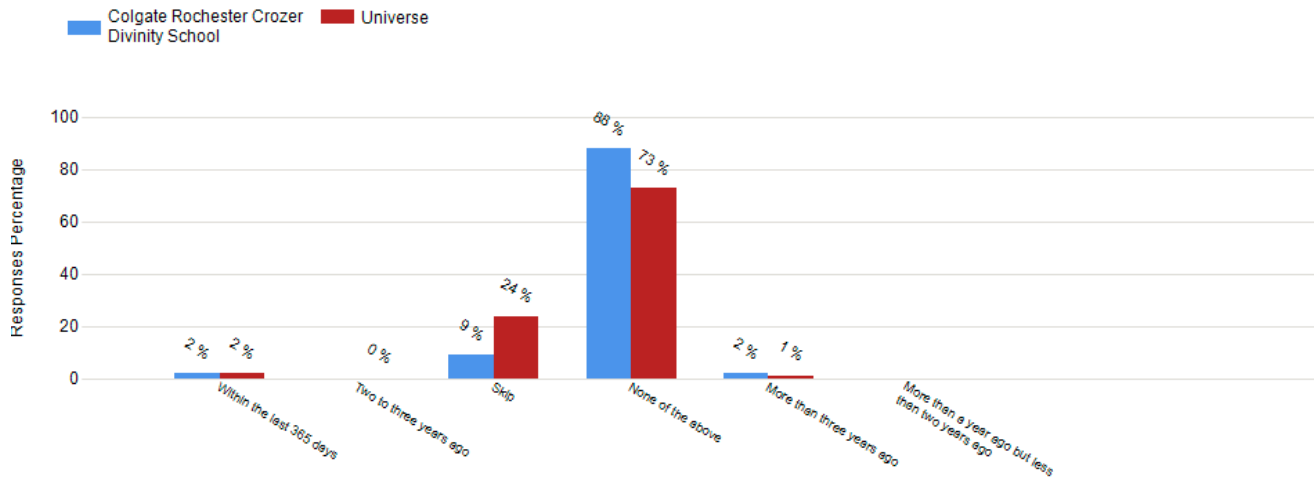
Have you faced stalking **off campus** during any of the following time periods:

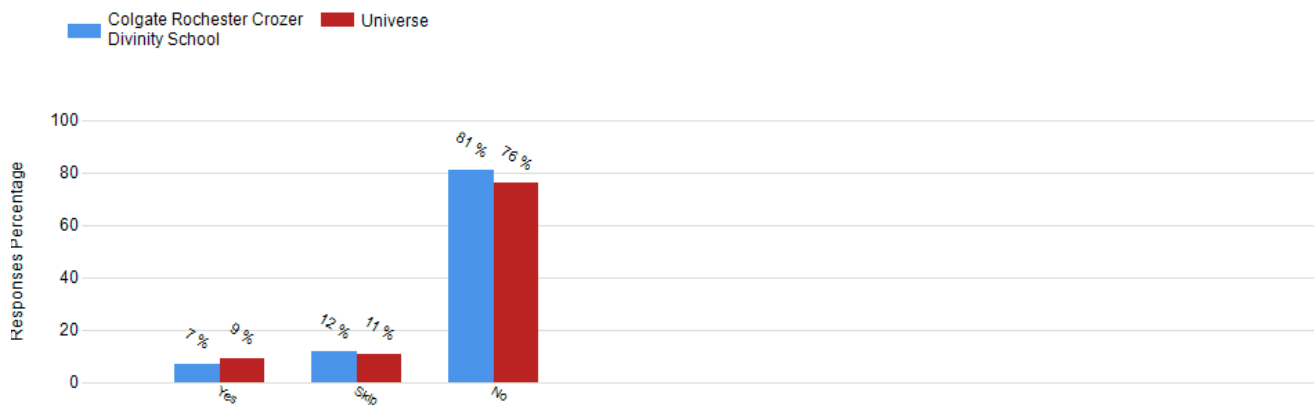
Have you faced stalking **on campus** during any of the following time periods:
